of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit  
for Southern California Petroleum Corp.  
Gutman well No. 1, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 18,  
Township 24 South, Range 37 East,  
Jalmat Gas Pool  
Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

By this application, Southern California Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval for a non-standard gas proration unit under Rule 5-B, Order No. R-520 and wishes to state that:

1. Subject well has an 80 acre allowable on the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 18, T24S, R37E, and is jointly owned by Southern California Petroleum Corporation and Western Natural Gas Company.
2. Southern California and Western Natural Gas Company also share a joint interest in the N $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18 and wish to communitize these joint interest properties for a 160 acre allowable for the Gutman well No. 1.
3. The non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lies wholly within a single governmental section which may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The subject well is now producing gas from the horizontal and vertical limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool.
5. The length or width of the unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
6. A plat is hereby attached to this application showing:
  - (a) Acreage to be dedicated;
  - (b) Well location;
  - (c) Offset ownership; and
  - (d) Offset gas wells.
7. The granting of this application will not affect adversely any offset operator but will serve to protect correlative rights.
