Pulled dual tubing strings. Ran Gamma Ray tie-in log from 7000' back to 3000'. Set Baker CIBP at 8050' and dumped two sacks cement on top. Set Baker Model "D" packer at 6800'. Ran tail pipe w/sealing nipple, one joint tubing, latch and seal assembly, Model L sleeve and tubing receptacle. Came out of hole with 2-3/8" tubing. Set retrievable bridge plug at 6000' by wireline. Dumped two sacks 20-40 sand. Perforated one 3/8" hole each at 5242, 49, 55, 63, 90, 96, 3319, 67, 86, 99, 3437 and 3445; a total of 12 holes. Ran 2-3/8" tubing and hung at 5470'. Treated Blinbry perforations w/1500 gals. 15% acid, plus 13 ball sealers. Max. press. 2800#. Fraced w/24,000 gals. lease oil and 43,000# 20-40 sand and 1/20# Adomite/gal. in lease oil. Killed well with brine water, could not get circulation to wash sand off bridge plug. Used Form Gel and oyster shells to block. Reversed out oyster shells, recovered bridge plug. Ran long string (#1) with LCH dual packer. Set at 6830'. Model "D" packer at 6796', Otis LCH dual packer at 5327'. Landed #2 string on dual packer at 5331'. Fished both plugs from #1 string. Swabbed Montoya zone in. Treated Blinbry down tubing with 500 gals. NE acid to remove block. On 24 hr. test, Blinbry flowed 67 BO, 4 BW on 16/64# choke. TP 1550#.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
