Gentlemen:

Our Cook No. 2 well was completed on February 6, 1969 as a Yates gas producer in the Jalmat gas Field and the SE/4 of Section 28, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico was established as the proration unit for gas production from the well. The No. 2 Cook well is currently producing gas from the Yates formation. Recently we re-entered our No. 1 Cook well also located in the SE/4 of Section 28 and, after attempting completion in the Queen formation, we plugged it back and are completing it as a Yates gas producer. We will therefore have two Jalmat Yates gas wells on the same 160 acre proration unit. Both wells comply with the field rules for standard locations. The Cook No. 2 well is located 660 feet from the south and east lines of Section 28 and the Cook No. 1 well is located 660 feet from the south line and 1980 from the east line of the same section. Plat showing location of the wells is enclosed.

We hereby make application to the Commission for authority to produce both the Cook No. 1 and the Cook No. 2 wells as Yates gas producers from the same proration unit, being the SE/4 of Section 28, with the allowable for both wells together being the regular allowable assigned to a 160 acre proration unit for Jalmat gas production.
