Dear Miss Renezar:

This office is in receipt of correspondence indicating your intent to create a non-standard gas proration unit with your Dyer Well No. 3, located in the NE/4 of Section 31, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. As of this date, we have not received a formal application from you requesting approval of the formation of this gas unit, and until this application is received this office can take no further action.

The letter of November 10, to which you refer, was Administrative Order NSL -4 which gave approval to the non-standard location of this well; however, this does not give per se authority for the formation of a non-standard proration unit.

We are in receipt of waivers to the formation of the non-standard gas proration unit from Stanolind Oil and Gas Company, Ralph Lowe, and Jerry Covington. If you will supply waivers to the formation of this gas unit from the other offset operators, Gulf and Continental, along with your formal application, we will give this matter immediate processing.
