- Rig up PU and pull rods and pump. Install BOP and pull 2 3/8" tubing.
- TIH with workstring and 4 3/4" bit and clean out 5 1/2" casing to top of liner at 3270.
- TOH with workstring and 4 3/4" bit. TIH with workstring and bit and clean out 4" 11.6# liner to ABTD (3610'). TOH with workstring and bit. TIH with workstring and RBP to ± 3000 and set RBP. Dump 35' of sand on RBP. TOH with workstring.
- Establish circulation out casing leaks at 788' in 5 1/2" casing.
- Determine required cement volume by pumping red dye.
- Squeeze 5 1/2" casing leaks using volume of class C cement as determined above.
- Flush to 700' with water. Shut casing in and WOC 24 hours.
- TIH with workstring and bit and drill out cement in 5 1/2" casing.
- Close the BOP and test the squeeze job to 300 psi by pressuring through the bit.
- TOH with workstring and bit. TIH with workstring and retrieving tool. TOH with RBP.
- TIH with production tubing rods and pump and return to production.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
