DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 1, 1953 at 4:00 A.M., 36 hours had elapsed since running 3839' of new 9-5/8" casing landed at 3855 and cemented in two stages as follows:

1st Stage: Cemented with 375 sacks mixed 8% gel plus 100 sacks neat cement.

2nd stage: Cemented through staging collar set at 1107 with 150 sacks neat cement. (Temperature survey indicated top of cement at 775')

Casing shut-off was tested with 1200 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling staging tool, and 1150 psi for 30 minutes after drilling shoe. Since there was no appreciable drop in pressure on any test, drilling operations were resumed.
