DCP Midstream, LP (DCP) is pleased to submit for your review, a copy of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2016 Groundwater Monitoring Results for the DCP J-4-2 Pipeline Release located in Lea County, New Mexico (Unit C, Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 35 East).

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2016 analytical results for BTEX show no detections above the NMWQCC standards. This is now a total of 12 quarters in which BTEX has not been detected above the NMWQCC Standards. Based on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2016 results along with the historical results, DCP will discontinue sampling BTEX at this site. Chlorides will continue to be sampled. If OCD does not agree with dropping BTEX from the J-4-2 sampling parameters, please let me know.
