Centennial Resource Production, LLC (OGRID No. 372165), pursuant to Division Rules 19.15.16.15(C)(6) and 19.15.15.13 NMAC and applicable rules governing acreage and well location requirements for the Ojo Chiso; Bone Spring, South pool [97293], seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Winnebago 30 State Com #602H well** (API No. 30-025-50273), in a 320-acre, more or less, spacing unit underlying the E/2 W/2 of Sections 19 and 30, T22S, R35E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The proposed location is as follows:

- Surface location: 300' FSL and 1100' FWL (Lot 4) of Section 30
- Bottom hole location: 100' FNL and 1905' FWL (Unit C) of Section 19
- First take point: 100' FSL and 1405' FWL (Unit N) of Section 30
- Last take point: 100' FNL and 1905' FWL (Unit C) of Section 19

Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than the standard offsets to the western boundary of the spacing unit – thus encroaching on the W/2 W/2 of Sections 19 and 30, T22S, R35E. As explained in the engineering statement included as **Exhibit A**, approval of the unorthodox,

completed interval will allow Centennial to use its preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area, which will maximize recovery and prevent waste.

Exhibit B is a Form C-102 showing the proposed Winnebago 30 State Com #602H well encroaches on the spacing unit/tracts to the west in the W/2 W/2 of Sections 19 and 30, T22S, R35E.

Exhibit C is a plat for Sections 19 and 30, T22S, R35E, that shows the proposed Winnebago 30 State Com #602H well in relation to the adjoining spacing unit/tracts to the west. Exhibit C also includes an ownership list for the affected spacing unit to the west, showing that it is owned by Centennial, as the working interest owner. In addition, the exhibit identifies that these are State leases. Accordingly, the “affected persons”¹ are the applicant, Centennial Resource Production, LLC, and the New Mexico State Land Office.

To Whom it May Concern,

Centennial Resource Production, LLC respectfully requests administrative approval on a non-standard location for the Winnebago 30 State Com 602H to allow the completed interval to be less than 330 feet from the western boundary of the existing 320.00-acre horizontal spacing unit. This well is located in the Ojo Chiso; Bone Spring, South pool [97293]. Due to the current spacing of the producing wells in this section, Centennial has planned the Winnebago 30 State Com 601H, 602H, 603H, 604H and 605H wells with at least 825 feet of spacing between each well. This spacing pattern causes the Winnebago 30 State Com 602H to be drilled less than 330 feet from the western boundary of the spacing unit. Centennial requests approval of this non-standard location to avoid causing wasted resources and reducing the production of the wells listed above.


