XTO Permian Operating, LLC (“XTO”) (OGRID No. 373075), pursuant to Division Rules 19.15.16.15(C)(6) and 19.15.15.13 NMAC and applicable rules governing acreage and well location requirements for the WC-015 2330S16 J Wolfcamp [98268]¹, seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Poker Lake Unit 21 DTD 174H** well (API No. 30-015-50184), in a 1280.75-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 33, Township 23 South, Range 30 East, and the E/2 of Sections 4, 9, and 16, Township 24 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The proposed location for the **Poker Lake Unit 21 DTD 174H** gas well is as follows:

- **SHL:** 1,127’ FNL and 1,456’ FEL (Unit B) of Section 21, T24S-R30E
- **FTP:** 100’ FSL and 1,430’ FEL (Unit O) of Section 21, T24S-R30E
- **LTP:** 100’ FNL and 1,430’ FEL (Unit B) of Section 33, T23S-R30E
- **BHL:** 50’ FNL and 1,430’ FEL (Unit B) of Section 33, T23S-R30E

Since the acreage in Section 33, Township 23 South, Range 30 East, is governed by the Division’s statewide gas rules, the projected last take point for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than the standard offset to the northern boundary of the spacing unit/unitized area—thus, encroaching on the tracts encompassing the E/2 of Section 28, Township 23 South, Range 30 East.²

XTO respectfully requests administrative approval of a non-standard location for the **Poker Lake Unit 21 DTD 174H** and provides the following reason for the request: Approval of the unorthodox, completed last take point is necessary to allow XTO to maximize recovery and prevent waste.

Exhibit A are the Form C-102s with the dedicated acreage for each pool the well penetrates, which show the proposed Poker Lake Unit 21 DTD 174H well encroaches on the tracts to the north in the E/2 of Section 28, Township 23 South, Range 30 East.

Exhibit B is a plat for the subject area, that shows the proposed Poker Lake Unit 21 DTD 174H well in relation to the adjoining tracts to the north. The affected working interest owners in the tracts to the north include ConocoPhillips Company, Devon Energy Production Company, L.P., and WPX Energy Permian, LLC. In addition, the exhibit identifies that this includes State Land Office (“SLO”) and Bureau of Land Management (“BLM”) leases. Accordingly, the “affected persons”³ are ConocoPhillips Company, Devon Energy Production Company, L.P., WPX Energy Permian, LLC, SLO, and BLM.

Exhibit C is a spreadsheet listing all affected persons requiring notice and includes tracking information demonstrating that each of the affected persons requiring notice was sent a copy of this application with all attachments by certified mail advising that any objections must be filed in writing with the Division within 20 days from the date the Division receives the application. 




