However, it appears additional work /modification to the completion interval may be planned and we wish to clarify the below items to include in the well file for completeness and future reference. In this regard, can you please clarify the following:

It is noted that the existing perforation interval (4069 - 4216 ft) will be expanded whereby the new perforation interval will extend from 4069 - 4230 ft.

Please confirm that the new perforations are within the approved injection interval. More specifically, OXY is requested to confirm the injection interval for the well is the stratigraphic equivalent of the Grayburg-San Andres formations as determined by the Borehole Compensated Sonic-Gamma Ray Log (dated July 9, 1969) for the Shell A State Well No.7 (Currently the North Hobbs G/SA Unit Well No. 424; API 20-025-23130) at a depth of 3698 feet to a depth of 4500 feet (Order No. R-6198-A) Yes, the proposed perfs are within G/SA as referred.
