Greetings Mr. Stone,

On October 22, 2025, Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") notified the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") that it is protesting the following SWD permit request application of Solaris Water Midstream, LLC ("Solaris") for disposal:

- Speedway SWD No. 1, Unit N, Section 29, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico

Mewbourne is identified as an affected person for the referenced application. For the application to proceed, Solaris has two options: either resolve the matter with the protesting party or go to a hearing before the Division. If the protest is withdrawn, then the application could be processed administratively. Meanwhile, OCD will retain your application until a resolution is reached on the status of the submittals. LEGAL NOTICE Solaris Water Midstream, LLC, 9651 Katy Freeway, Suite 400, Houston, Texas, 77024, is filing Form C-108 (Application for Authority to Inject) with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking administrative approval for a salt water disposal well. The proposed well, **Speedway** SWD No.1, (API 30-015-TBD) will be located 40' FSL and 2439 FWL, Section 29, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Produced water from area production will be commercially disposed into the Bell Canyon and Cherry Canyon formations at a depth of 2,166' to 3,852' at a maximum surface pressure of 433 psi with a maximum daily rate of 18,500 bwpd and an average daily rate of 12,500 bwpd. The proposed SWD well is located approximately 9.7 miles south/ southwest of Carlsbad, NM. Interested parties wishing to object to the proposed application must file with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, 1220 St. Francis
