You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. 19.15.16.15(B)(1)(a) NMAC governs this proposed well and provides that the operator dedicate a horizontal well at a standard horizontal spacing unit that comprises of one or more contiguous tracts that the horizontal well's completed interval penetrates, each of which consists of a governmental quarter - quarter section or equivalent. 19.15.16.15(C)(1)(a) NMAC governs the distance in the horizontal plane from any point in the

completed interval to any outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit, measured along a line perpendicular to the completed interval or to the tangent thereof, shall be a minimum of 330 feet for an oil well. 19.15.16.15(C)(1)(b) NMAC governs the first and last take point of a horizontal well shall be no closer than 100 feet for a well within the horizontal plane, to any outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit.

The request to deviate from an orthodox location has met all requirements of 19.15.16.15 (C)(5)(a) NMAC. It is understood that you are seeking this exception in order to create a non-standard location, comprised of Take Points referenced above, within the described Horizontal Spacing Unit.

This well's completed interval is as close as 25 feet to the southern edge of the horizontal spacing unit. Encroachment will impact the following tracts.

Section 03, T25S R32E, encroachment to the NE/4 NE/4

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in 19.15.2.7(A)(8) NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.

The Division understands you are seeking this unorthodox location for the greatest recovery of reserves from the unit within the Wolfcamp formation allowing for full and efficient development underlying the E/2 of Section 34 and the E/2 of Section 27, thereby preventing waste.

Your application has been filed under 19.15.16.15(C)(6) NMAC, 19.15.15.13 NMAC and 19.15.4.12 (A)(2) NMAC.

Per 19.15.15.13 (B) NMAC, **Division approves this unorthodox location.**

Reference this NSL order number on the As Drilled C-102 submitted with the Authorization to Transport, to place this well into production.

Pursuant to Division rules 19.15.16.15(C)(6) and 19.15.15.13 NMAC, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. ("Chevron") (OGRID No. 4323) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location ("NSL") for its CO 34 27 Federal Com 637H well (API No. 30-025-54287) (the "Well") located in a 640-acre, more or less, standard¹ horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Sections 27 and 34, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and will be in the WC-025 G-08 S253216D; UPR Wolfcamp pool (Pool Code 98270). A C-102 for the Well is attached as Exhibit A.

Chevron is requesting this NSL to allow for full and efficient development of this acreage.

The horizontal spacing unit to which the Well will be dedicated is described as:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Acres</u>	<u>Pool</u>	<u>Pool Code</u>
E/2 of Sections 27 & 34	640	WC-025 G-08 S253216D	98270

The WC-025 G-08 S253216D; UPR Wolfcamp Pool is an oil pool subject to the state-wide rules, which establish a 100' setback requirement for the first and last take points of a well to the outer boundary of the spacing unit. The Well's **first take point** will be closer than 100' from the outer boundary of the spacing unit, which requires an NSL approval. As shown on Exhibit A, this is a horizontal well that will be drilled as follows:

- Surface Hole Location: 675' FNL & 396' FEL (Unit A) of Section 3-T25S-R32E;
- Bottom Hole Location: 25' FNL & 330' FEL (Unit A) of Section 27-T24S-R32E;
- First Take Point: 25' FSL & 330' FEL (Unit P) of Section 34-T24S-R32E;

¹ The 640-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit in which the Well will be located is standard because there is a proximity tract well within the unit, which is the CO 34 27 Federal Com 608H well (API 30-025-53555), with a completed lateral closer than 330' from the quarter quarter section lines in the E/2 of Sections 34 and 27.

- Last Take Point: 100' FNL & 330' FEL (Unit A) of Section 27-T24S-R32E.


Chevron has provided a map of the area, attached as Exhibit B, which shows the tracts upon which the unorthodox location will encroach.

As discussed above, the Well's **first take point** will be closer than 100' from the outer boundary of the spacing unit. *See* Exhibit A (C-102). The unorthodox location will encroach towards the N/2NE/4 of Section 3, Township 25 South, Range 32 East.

Chevron is the operator and owns 100% of the working interest in the N/2NE/4 of Section 3, Township 25 South, Range 32 East. Pursuant to Rule 19.15.4.12(A)(2) and Rule 19.15.2.7(A)(3), Chevron is thus only providing notice to the Bureau of Land Management. Proof of mailing along with a copy of the letter sent to the Bureau of Land Management are included in Exhibit C. Chevron's landman has provided a letter confirming the ownership in the N/2NE/4 of Section 3, Township 25 South, Range 32 East, which is included as Exhibit D. Chevron has included as Exhibit E a letter explaining why this application is needed.
