SELF-AFFIRMED DECLARATION OF JEFF BROUSSARD

Jeff Broussard states and declares as follows:

BACKGROUND

1. I am a landman for Marathon Oil Permian ("Marathon"), over the age of 18, and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my credentials as an expert petroleum landman were accepted by the Division as a matter of record.

2. My area of responsibility at Marathon includes the Delaware Basin and Lea County.

3. I am familiar with the application filed by Marathon in Case Number 22332, which

is attached as Exhibit B.1.

4. I submit the following information pursuant to NMAC 19.15.4.12.A(1) in support of the above referenced application.

5. I am familiar with the status of the lands that are subject to this application.

6. The purpose of the application is to force pool all uncommitted interests into the horizontal spacing unit described below, and in the well to be drilled in the unit.

7. No opposition is expected because the interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed well, but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests in the well.



8. In this case, Marathon seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a standard 640-acre Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit underlying the E/2 of Sections 18 and 19, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

9. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the **Colossus 18-19 WA Federal Com 1H** well to be horizontally drilled.

10. Attached as Exhibit **B.2** is the proposed C-102 for the well.

11. The C-102 identifies the proposed surface hole location, the first take point, and the bottom hole location. The C-102 also identifies the pool and pool code.

 The well will develop the JABALINA;WOLFCAMP, SOUTHWEST Pool (Pool Code 96776). This pool is an oil pool with 40-acre building blocks.

13. This pool is governed by the state-wide horizontal well rules. The producing interval for the well will be orthodox and will comply with the Division's set back requirements.

14. The completed interval for the **Colossus 18-19 WA Federal Com 1H** well is less than 330 feet from the adjoining tracts and the Division's rules allow for the inclusion of proximity tracts within the proposed spacing unit for the well.

15. There are no depth severances within the proposed spacing unit.

16. **Exhibit B.3** includes a lease tract map outlining the unit being pooled. Exhibit B.3 also includes the parties being pooled, the nature, and the percent of their interests.

17. I have conducted a diligent search of the public records in the county where the well will be located, and conducted phone directory and computer searches to locate contact information for parties entitled to notification, and mailed the working interest owners well proposals, including an Authorization for Expenditure.

18. In my opinion, Marathon has made a good faith effort to obtain voluntary joinder in the proposed well.

19. **Exhibit B.4** is a summary of my contacts with the various working interest owners.

20. **Exhibit B.5** is a sample of the well proposal letter that was sent. The proposal letter included typos regarding the proposed surface hole and bottom hole locations for the well. Marathon provided the correct footages in its application, which I restate in my declaration. The proposal letter also included the TVD and MD.

21. The first take point will be 1,452 feet from the East line, 100 feet from the North line of Section 18, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

22. The last take point will be 1,452 feet from the East line, 100 feet from the South line of Section 19, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

23. **Exhibit B.6** contains the Authorization for Expenditure for the proposed well. The estimated cost of the well set forth therein is fair and reasonable, and is comparable to the costs of other wells of similar depths and length drilled in this area of New Mexico.

24. Marathon requests overhead and administrative rates of \$7500.00/month for drilling a well and \$750.00/month for a producing well. These rates are fair, and comparable to the rates charged by other operators for wells of this type in this area of Southeastern, New Mexico. Marathon requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the COPAS Accounting Procedure.

25. Marathon requests the maximum cost plus 200% risk charge be assessed against non-consenting working interest owners.

26. Marathon requests that it be designated operator of the well.

27. The parties Marathon is seeking to pool were notified of this hearing.

28. Marathon seeks to pool overriding royalty interest owners, and they were provided notice of this hearing.

29. **Exhibit B.7** is a declaration of notice prepared by counsel for Marathon that shows the parties who were notified of this hearing, the status of whether they received notice, and an affidavit of publication from the Hobbs News-Sun newspaper, showing that notice of this hearing was published on November 12, 2021.

30. The attachments to this declaration were prepared by me, or compiled from company business records, or were prepared at my direction.

31. In my opinion, the granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

APPLICATION

Marathon Oil Permian LLC ("Marathon"), OGRID Number 372098, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes an application to the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA (1978), Section 70-2-17, for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit underlying the E/2 of Sections 18 and 19, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, Marathon states as follows:

1. Marathon is an interest owner in the subject lands and has a right to drill a well thereon.

2. Marathon seeks to dedicate the E/2 of Sections 18 and 19, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico to form a 640-acre, more or less, spacing unit.

3. Marathon plans to drill the **Colossus 18-19 WA Federal Com 1H** well to a depth sufficient to test the Wolfcamp formation. This well will be horizontally drilled and will be drilled at an orthodox location under the Division's rules.



4. The completed interval for the Colossus 18-19 WA Federal Com 1H well is less than 330 feet from the adjoining tracts and the Division's rules allow for the inclusion of proximity tracts within the proposed spacing unit for the wells.

5. The first take point will be 1,452 feet from the East line, 100 feet from the North line of Section 18, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

6. The last take point will be 1,452 feet from the East line, 100 feet from the South line of Section 19, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

7. Marathon sought, but has been unable to obtain, a voluntary agreement from all interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the proposed spacing unit to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well.

8. The pooling of all interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the proposed unit will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Marathon requests this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on December 2, 2021, and after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order:

A. Pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit within the E/2 of Sections 18 and 19, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico;

B. Designating Marathon as operator of this unit and the well to be drilled thereon;

C. Authorizing Marathon to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well;

D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision,

together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure;

E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the

well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

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Summary of Attempted Contacts

- Marathon conducted extensive title work to determine the working interest owners and other interest owners.
- Marathon searched public records, phone directory, and various different types of internet searches.
- Marathon sent well proposal letters to the working interest owners on or around September 2021.
- Marathon proposed general terms of a Joint Operating Agreement (JOA) within the well proposal letters sent to working interest owners and indicated that a copy of the JOA would be provided upon request.
- Marathon and OXY have had multiple communications and have been negotiating JOA in this unit and nearby acreage.
- Marathon had discussions with Sharbro Energy, LLC. Sharbro initially stated that it wanted to participate in the wells, but never signed the JOA. Marathon called Sharbro on a number of occasions, including to discuss the upcoming hearing, but Sharbro did not return Marathon's call.
- Marathon filed applications to force pool parties who had not entered in to an agreement.
- Marathon's counsel sent notices of the force pooling applications to the addresses of record for the uncommitted interest owners.
- Marathon also published notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where the wells will be located.

Matt Baker declares states as follows:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a geologist for Marathon Oil Permian. LLC ("Marathon"), and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein.
 - 2. I have previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and

my credentials were accepted as a matter of record.

3. My work for Marathon includes the Permian Basin and Lea County in New Mexico.

4. I am familiar with the applications filed by Marathon in Case Number 22332 and the land matters involved.

5. I conducted a geological study of the areas embracing Marathon's Colossus Development Area.

6. As part of my study, I have prepared the following geological exhibits with respect to the horizontal spacing unit:

7. **Exhibit C.1** is a locator map showing the approximate location of the proposed Colossus Development Area in relation to the Capitan Reef.

8. **Exhibit C.2** is a wellbore schematic showing Marathon's development plan.

9. Exhibit C.3 is structure map of the top of the Wolfcamp A. The proposed spacing unit is identified by a dashed black box. The Colossus 18-19 WA Federal Com 1H is identified

OCD Examiner Hearing 5-19-22 Released to Infugen 32: 5/17/2022 3:07:37 PM by a red dashed line identified by the box labeled "1". The contour interval used this exhibit is 25 feet. This exhibit shows that the structure dips to the southwest over the project area.

10. **Exhibit C.4** is a cross section reference map that identifies two wells in the vicinity of the proposed wells, shown by a line of cross-section running from A to A'.

11. **Exhibit C.5** is a stratigraphic cross section hung on the top of the Wolfcamp. The well logs on the cross-section give a representative sample of Wolfcamp A formation in the area. The target zone is identified by green shading and a red arrow. In my opinion, the gross interval thickness is near constant thickness across the project area.

12. **Exhibit C.6** is a Gross Interval Isochore of the top of the Wolfcamp A to the top of the Wolfcamp B. The Wolfcamp A is near constant thickness across the project area.

- 13. I conclude from my study that:
 - a. The horizontal spacing unit is justified from a geologic standpoint.
 - b. There are no structural impediments or faulting that will interfere with horizontal development.
 - c. Each quarter quarter section in the proposed unit will contribute more or less equally to production.

14. Exhibit C.7 provides an overview of the stress orientation in the area based on the2020 Lund Snee-Zoback paper.

15. The preferred well orientation in this area is either north/south or south/north.

16. The attachments to this declaration were prepared by me, or compiled from company business records, or were prepared at my direction.
