I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my qualifications as an expert in petroleum land matters were accepted and made a matter of record.

2. I am familiar with Spur's application in the above-referenced case and with the status of the lands in the subject area. A copy of Spur's application and proposed notice are attached as **Exhibit A-1**.

3. None of the parties proposed to be pooled in this case indicated opposition to this matter proceeding by affidavit, therefore I do not expect any opposition at hearing.

4. On March 9, 2022, the Division issued Order No. R-22062 in Case No. 22533, which pooled uncommitted interests from the top of the Yeso formation to a depth of approximately 4,000' (Artesia; Glorieta.-Yeso Pool, Code 96830) in a 160-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit ("Unit") comprised of the N/2 S/2 of Section 27, Township 17 South, Range 28 East in Eddy County, New Mexico. The Order dedicated the Unit to the Halberd 27 State Com 21H well ("Well") and designated Spur as the operator of the Unit and the Well.

5. A copy of Order No. R-22062 is attached as Exhibit A-2.

6. Since the Order was entered, Spur has identified additional interest owners in the Unit that have not been pooled under the terms of the Order.

7. **Exhibit A-3** provides a plat of the tracts included in the HSU, identifies the interests in each tract included in the HSU, and identifies the additional uncommitted interests to be pooled under the terms of Order No. R-22062, which are highlighted in yellow. None of the interest owners are unlocatable.

8. Exhibit A-4 is a sample well proposal letter that I sent to the working interest owners.

9. In my opinion, Spur has made a good-faith effort to reach voluntary joinder as indicated by the chronology of contact described in Exhibit A-5.

10. Spur requests the additional mineral interest owners be pooled under the terms of Order No. R-22062.

In my opinion, the granting of Spur's application would serve the interests of 11. conservation and the prevention of waste.

12. The attached exhibits attached were either prepared by me or under my supervision or were compiled from company business records.

13. I understand that this Self-Affirmed Statement will be used as written testimony in this case. APPLICATION

Spur Energy Partners, LLC, OGRID No. 328947 ("Spur") files this application with the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") for the limited purpose of pooling additional interest owners under the terms of Division Order No. R-22062. In support of its application, Spur states as follows.

1. On March 9, 2022, the Division issued Order No. R-22062 in Case No. 22533, which pooled uncommitted interests from the top of the Yeso formation to a depth of approximately 4,000' (Artesia; Glorieta-Yeso Pool, Code 96830) in a 160-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit ("Unit") comprised of the N/2 S/2 of Section 27, Township 17 South, Range 28 East in Eddy County, New Mexico. The Order dedicated the Unit to the **Halberd 27 State Com 21H** well ("Well") and designated Spur as operator of the Unit and the Well.

2. Since entry of the Order, Spur has identified additional interest owners in the Unit that have not been pooled under the terms of the Order.

3. Spur has undertaken diligent, good-faith efforts to obtain voluntary agreements from the additional interest owners to participate in the drilling of the Well but has been unable to obtain voluntary agreements from the owners.

4. In order to permit Spur to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the additional interest owners should be pooled into the Unit pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Spur Energy Partners, LLC Case No. 22738 Exhibit A-1 5. The pooling of the additional interest owners will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Division on May 5, 2022, and after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division pool the additional interest owners into the Unit pursuant to the terms of Division Order No. R-22062.

ORDER

The Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD"), having heard this matter through a Hearing Examiner on February 3, 2022, and after considering the testimony, evidence, and recommendation of the Hearing Examiner, issues the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Spur Energy Partners, LLC ("Operator") submitted an application ("Application") to compulsory pool the uncommitted oil and gas interests within the spacing unit ("Unit") described in Exhibit A. The Unit is expected to be a standard horizontal spacing unit. 19.15.16.15(B) NMAC. Operator seeks to be designated the operator of the Unit.
- 2. Operator will dedicate the well(s) described in Exhibit A ("Well(s)") to the Unit.
- 3. Operator proposes the supervision and risk charges for the Well(s) described in Exhibit A.
- 4. Operator identified the owners of uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals in the Unit and provided evidence that notice was given.
- 5. The Application was heard by the Hearing Examiner on the date specified above, during which Operator presented evidence through affidavits in support of the Application. No other party presented evidence at the hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 6. OCD has jurisdiction to issue this Order pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.
- 7. Operator is the owner of an oil and gas working interest within the Unit.
- 8. Operator satisfied the notice requirements for the Application and the hearing as required by 19.15.4.12 NMAC.
- 9. OCD satisfied the notice requirements for the hearing as required by 19.15.4.9 NMAC.
- 10. Operator has the right to drill the Well(s) to a common source of supply at the

depth(s) and location(s) in the Unit described in Exhibit A.

- 11. The Unit contains separately owned uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals.
- 12. Some of the owners of the uncommitted interests have not agreed to commit their interests to the Unit.
- 13. The pooling of uncommitted interests in the Unit will prevent waste and protect correlative rights, including the drilling of unnecessary wells.
- 14. This Order affords to the owner of an uncommitted interest the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the oil or gas in the pool.

<u>ORDER</u>

- 15. The uncommitted interests in the Unit are pooled as set forth in Exhibit A.
- 16. The Unit shall be dedicated to the Well(s) set forth in Exhibit A.
- 17. Operator is designated as operator of the Unit and the Well(s).
- 18. If the location of a well will be unorthodox under the spacing rules in effect at the time of completion, Operator shall obtain the OCD's approval for a non-standard location in accordance with 19.15.16.15(C) NMAC.
- 19. The Operator shall commence drilling the Well(s) within one year after the date of this Order, and complete each Well no later than one (1) year after the commencement of drilling the Well.
- 20. This Order shall terminate automatically if Operator fails to comply with Paragraph 19 unless Operator obtains an extension by amending this Order for good cause shown.
- 21. The infill well requirements in 19.15.13.9 NMAC through 19.15.13.12 NMAC shall be applicable.
- 22. Operator shall submit each owner of an uncommitted working interest in the pool ("Pooled Working Interest") an itemized schedule of estimated costs to drill, complete, and equip the well ("Estimated Well Costs").
- 23. No later than thirty (30) days after Operator submits the Estimated Well Costs, the owner of a Pooled Working Interest shall elect whether to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs or its share of the actual costs to drill, complete and equip the well ("Actual Well Costs") out of production from the well. An owner of a Pooled Working Interest who elects to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs shall render payment to Operator no later than thirty (30) days after the expiration of the election period, and shall be liable for operating costs, but not risk charges, for the

CASE NO. 22533 ORDER NO. R-22062 well. An owner of a Pooled Working Interest who fails to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs or who elects to pay its share of the Actual Well Costs out of production from the well shall be considered to be a "Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest."

- 24. No later than one hundred eighty (180) days after Operator submits a Form C-105 for a well, Operator shall submit to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest an itemized schedule of the Actual Well Costs. The Actual Well Costs shall be considered to be the Reasonable Well Costs unless an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a written objection no later than forty-five (45) days after receipt of the schedule. If an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a timely written objection, OCD shall determine the Reasonable Well Costs after public notice and hearing.
- 25. No later than sixty (60) days after the expiration of the period to file a written objection to the Actual Well Costs or OCD's order determining the Reasonable Well Costs, whichever is later, each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs shall pay to Operator its share of the Reasonable Well Costs that exceed the Estimated Well Costs, or Operator shall pay to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs that exceed the Estimated Well Costs its share of the Estimated Well Costs that exceed the Reasonable Well Costs its share of the Estimated Well Costs that exceed the Reasonable Well Costs.
- 26. The reasonable charges for supervision to drill and produce a well ("Supervision Charges") shall not exceed the rates specified in Exhibit A, provided however that the rates shall be adjusted annually pursuant to the COPAS form entitled "Accounting Procedure-Joint Operations."
- 27. No later than within ninety (90) days after Operator submits a Form C-105 for a well, Operator shall submit to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest an itemized schedule of the reasonable charges for operating and maintaining the well ("Operating Charges"), provided however that Operating Charges shall not include the Reasonable Well Costs or Supervision Charges. The Operating Charges shall be considered final unless an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a written objection no later than forty-five (45) days after receipt of the schedule. If an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a timely written objection, OCD shall determine the Operating Charges after public notice and hearing.
- 28. Operator may withhold the following costs and charges from the share of production due to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs: (a) the proportionate share of the Supervision Charges; and (b) the proportionate share of the Operating Charges.
- 29. Operator may withhold the following costs and charges from the share of production due to each owner of a Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest: (a) the proportionate share of the Reasonable Well Costs; (b) the proportionate share

CASE NO. 22533 ORDER NO. R-22062 of the Supervision and Operating Charges; and (c) the percentage of the Reasonable Well Costs specified as the charge for risk described in Exhibit A.

- 30. Operator shall distribute a proportionate share of the costs and charges withheld pursuant to paragraph 29 to each Pooled Working Interest that paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs.
- 31. Each year on the anniversary of this Order, and no later than ninety (90) days after each payout, Operator shall provide to each owner of a Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest a schedule of the revenue attributable to a well and the Supervision and Operating Costs charged against that revenue.
- 32. Any cost or charge that is paid out of production shall be withheld only from the share due to an owner of a Pooled Working Interest. No cost or charge shall be withheld from the share due to an owner of a royalty interests. For the purpose of this Order, an unleased mineral interest shall consist of a seven-eighths (7/8) working interest and a one-eighth (1/8) royalty interest.
- 33. Except as provided above, Operator shall hold the revenue attributable to a well that is not disbursed for any reason for the account of the person(s) entitled to the revenue as provided in the Oil and Gas Proceeds Payment Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 70-10-1 *et seq.*, and relinquish such revenue as provided in the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 7-8A-1 *et seq.*
- 34. The Unit shall terminate if (a) the owners of all Pooled Working Interests reach a voluntary agreement; or (b) the well(s) drilled on the Unit are plugged and abandoned in accordance with the applicable rules. Operator shall inform OCD no later than thirty (30) days after such occurrence.
- 35. OCD retains jurisdiction of this matter for the entry of such orders as may be deemed necessary.

SEP Permian LLC, an affiliate of Spur Energy Partners LLC, ("Spur"), hereby proposes to drill and complete the **Halberd 27 State Com 21H as a horizontal Yeso** well (the "Subject Well") to the approximate total vertical depth as referenced below at the following proposed location (subject to change upon staking of the wells and/or pads).

Halberd 27 State Com 21H well - Horizontal Yeso Well, Eddy County, NM

- Proposed Surface Hole Location 1845' FSL & 465' FEL, Section 28, T17S-R28E
- Proposed Bottom Hole Location 1900' FSL & 50' FEL, Section 27, T17S-R28E
- TVD: 3900'
- Total AFE: \$3,227,000

Spur proposes to form a Drilling Spacing Unit ("DSU") covering the North Half of the South Half (N2S2) of Section 27-T17S-R28E, Eddy County, New Mexico, containing 160 acres of land, more or less, from the top of the Yeso formation to 4000'. Portions of these lands are likely governed by existing Joint Operating Agreements ("JOAs") which also cover the Yeso formation and which govern operations for vertical wells. For the mutually exclusive development of horizontal wells, and any concept wells (i.e micro seismic wells, pilot hole wells) within the DSU, Spur hereby submits for your consideration, a new Joint Operating Agreement dated April 1, 2022, being a modified 2015 Horizontal AAPL Form 610 Operating Agreement ("NJOA") to govern proposals and operations within the DSU. The NJOA shall supersede any existing operations under any JOAs, expressly limited however, to horizontal well development and related concept wells and operations within the DSU. The NJOA has the following general provisions:

- Effective Date of April 1, 2022
- Contract Area consisting of N2S2 of Section 27, Township 17 South, Range 28 East limited to a depth from the top of the Yeso to 4000'
- 100%/300%/300% non-consenting penalty
- \$8,000/\$800 drilling and producing monthly overhead rate
