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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

In **Case No. 25039**, Read and Stevens seeks an order to amend Order No. R-22748-A ("Order") to allow for an extension of time for drilling the proposed initial well under the Order. On June 15, 2023, the Division entered Order R-22748 in Case 23524 pooling the uncommitted interest in the Bone Spring formation (Teas; Bone Spring [58960]) underlying a standard 320.95-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit comprised of Lot 4, SW/4 NW/4 and the W/2 SW/4 of Section 3, and the W/2 W/2 of Section 10, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the "Unit"). Permian Resources Operating, LLC ("Permian") is the

designated operator of the Unit and Order R-22748 dedicates the Unit to the proposed initial **Riddler 3-10 Fed Com #111H** (API No. 30-025-53912), **Riddler 3-10 Fed Com #121H** (API No. 30-025-53916) and **Riddler 10 Fed Com #122H** (API No. 30-025-53917). In May of 2024, Read & Stevens filed an application in Case 24518 to extend the drilling deadline, noting that there was good cause to do so. Following a public hearing on the request, the Division issued order R-22748-A extending until June 16, 2025, the period to drill the proposed wells.

In **Case No. 25040**, Read and Stevens seeks an order to amend Order No. R-22749-A (“Order”) to allow for an extension of time for drilling the proposed initial well under the Order. On June 15, 2023, the Division entered Order R-22749 in Case 23525 pooling the uncommitted interest in the Bone Spring formation (Teas; Bone Spring [58960]) underlying a standard 320.85-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit comprised of Lot 3, SE/4 NW/4 and the E/2 SW/4 of Section 3, and the E/2 W/2 of Section 10, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the “Unit”). Permian Resources Operating, LLC (“Permian”) is the designated operator of the Unit and Order R-22749 dedicates the Unit to the proposed initial **Riddler 3-10 Fed Com #112H** (API No. 30-025-53913), **Riddler 3-10 Fed Com #123H** (API No. 30-025-53918) and **Riddler 10 Fed Com #124H** (API No. 30-025-53919). In May of 2024, Read & Stevens filed an application in Case 24520 to extend the drilling deadline, noting that there was good cause to do so. Following a public hearing on the request, the Division issued order R-22749-A extending until June 16, 2025, the period to drill the proposed wells.

In **Case No. 25041**, Read and Stevens seeks an order to amend Order No. R-22750-A (“Order”) to allow for an extension of time for drilling the proposed initial well under the Order. On June 15, 2023, the Division entered Order R-22750 in Case 23526 pooling the uncommitted interest in the Bone Spring formation (Teas; Bone Spring [58960]) underlying a standard

320.75-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit comprised of Lot 2, SW/4 NE/4 and the W/2 SE/4 of Section 3, and the W/2 E/2 of Section 10, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the “Unit”). Permian Resources Operating, LLC (“Permian”) is the designated operator of the Unit and Order R-22750 dedicates the Unit to the proposed initial **Riddler 3-10 Fed Com #113H** (API No. 30-025-53914), **Riddler 3-10 Fed Com #125H** (API No. 30-025-53920) and **Riddler 10 Fed Com #126H** (API No. 30-025-53921). In May of 2024, Read & Stevens filed an application in Case 24519 to extend the drilling deadline, noting that there was good cause to do so. Following a public hearing on the request, the Division issued order R-22750-A extending until June 16, 2025, the period to drill the proposed wells.

In **Case No. 25042**, Read and Stevens seeks an order to amend Order No. R-22751-A (“Order”) to allow for an extension of time for drilling the proposed initial well under the Order. On June 15, 2023, the Division entered Order R-22751 in Case 23527 pooling the uncommitted interest in the Bone Spring formation (Teas; Bone Spring [58960]) underlying a standard 320.65-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit comprised of Lot 1, SE/4 NE/4 and the E/2 SE/4 of Section 3, and the E/2 E/2 of Section 10, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the “Unit”). Permian Resources Operating, LLC (“Permian”) is the designated operator of the Unit and Order R-22751 dedicates the Unit to the proposed initial **Riddler 3-10 Fed Com #114H** (API No. 30-025-53915), **Riddler 3-10 Fed Com #127H** (API No. 30-025-53922) and **Riddler 10 Fed Com #128H** (API No. 30-025-53923). In May of 2024, Read & Stevens filed an application in Case 24521 to extend the drilling deadline, noting that there was good cause to do so. Following a public hearing on the request, the Division issued order R-22751-A extending until June 16, 2025, the period to drill the proposed wells.

Permian is eager to develop this acreage and is seeking to co-develop it with Section 4, 5, 8, and 9 directly adjacent to the west for maximum efficiency and recovery. Permian anticipates a resolution on contested pooling cases on those adjacent lands in the coming months. Good cause therefore exists to extend the deadline to commence drilling under the order. Permian has reached an agreement with Alpha Energy Partners, LLC (“Alpha”) regarding timeframe to commence drilling and therefore requests an extension to October 15, 2025.
