## **REVISED MOTION TO DISMISS**

- Mewbourne's pooling applications and those of MRC Permian Company ("MRC") overlap only as to the W/2 Sec. 29, Township 22 South, Ramge 28 East, NMPM.
- Mewbourne originally believed that it and its partner working interest owners controlled the largest combined interest in the W/2 Sec. 29. However, it now appears that the COG entities are supporting MRC's applications, thus effectively countering MOC's argument.
- That and other factors (including the party initializing proceedings, which is MRC) 3. leads Mewbourne to believe that it should let MRC proceed uncontested with its applications, and fight another day.
