**NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S AGREED MOTION FOR  
CONTINUANCE**

**NOW COMES** Movant, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD"), moves for an order continuing the hearing on the above Notice of Violation ("NOV"), and in support thereof, states:

1. The above-referenced matter is currently set for hearing on May 5, 2026.
2. Respondent, Finaly Resources, LLC, has agreed with the undersigned to continue the hearing until June 25, 2026, since Respondent has executed an SFO that is still awaiting final approval by OCD. Given the prospect of the wells being brought into compliance and a settlement of the NOV being likely, OCD agreed with Respondent to a short continuance of this case until the June 25, 2026 OCD docket.
3. This continuance is not being sought for purposes of delay, but so that justice may be done. A proposed order is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Movant requests that this case be continued to the June 25, 2026 OCD docket.
