Application is hereby submitted seeking administrative approval for expansion of the West McMillan Anderson Pressure Maintenance Project by completing the Anderson No. 3 well for injection of water into the Queen Formation. The Anderson No. 3 is located 2310 feet from the East line and 990 feet from the South line of Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and is presently shut in.

The proposed conversion is submitted in the interest of conservation and should result in greater ultimate recovery of oil, thereby preventing waste. The anticipated rate of injection is 20 BWPD at 400 psi through 2 3/8-inch coated tubing and packing at about 480', open hole pay at 531 feet to 539 feet.

The pressure maintenance project was initiated on November 23, 1969, in accordance with the provisions set out in Order No. R-3852, Case No. 4225, by injecting water into Anderson



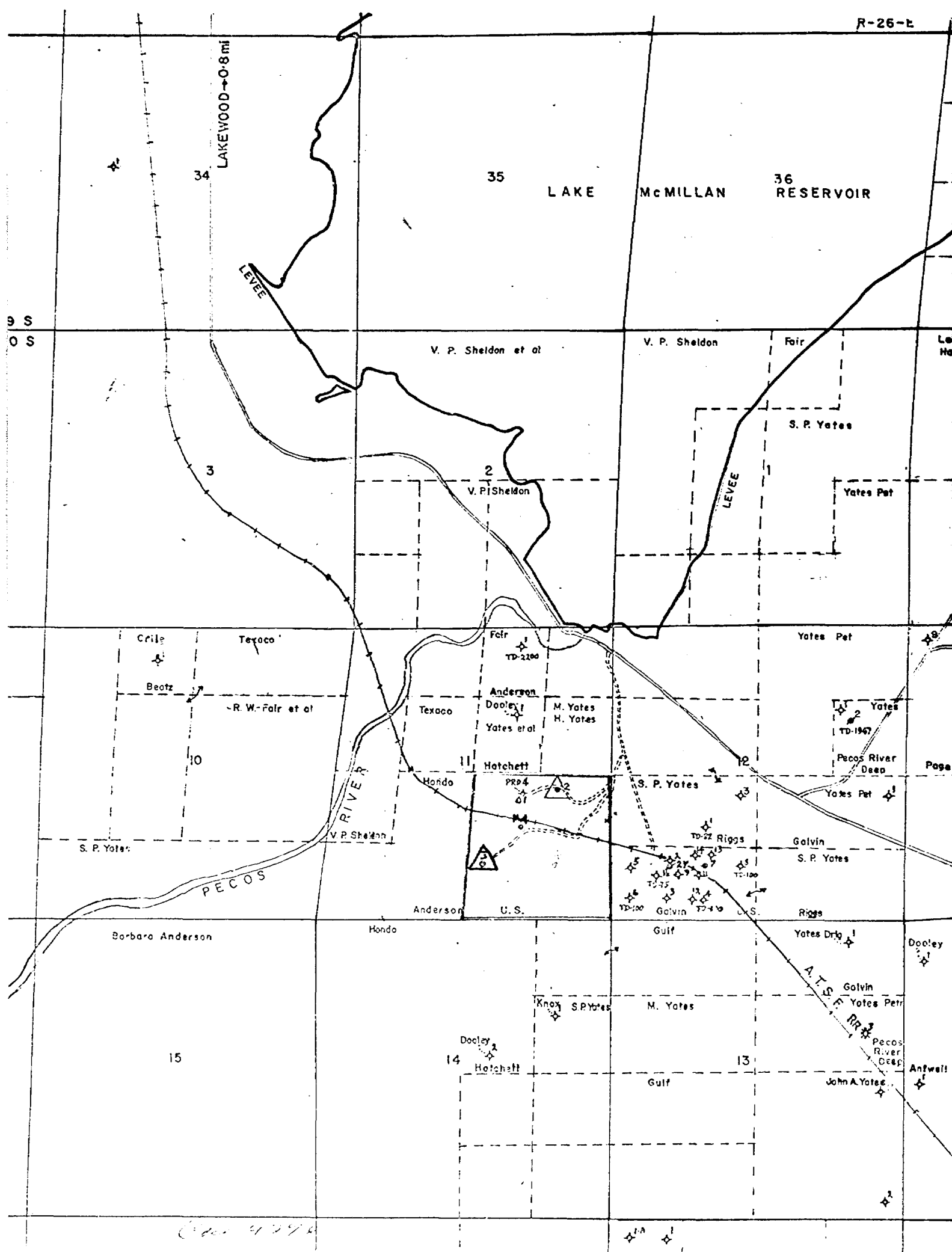

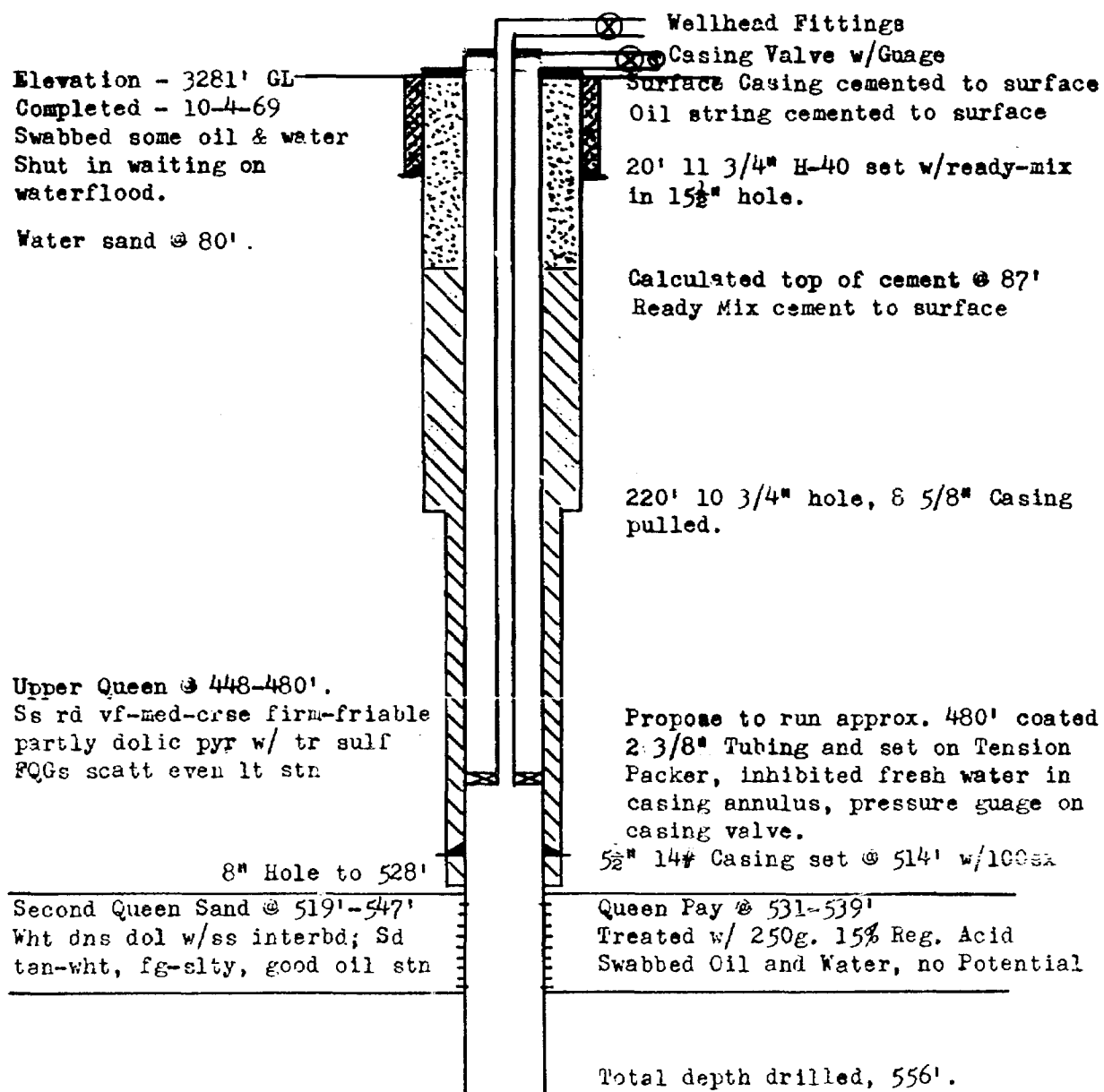
