From the contents thereof, we assume that Dr. Smith and Mr. Slaughter have satisfied the Conservation Commission to the extent of obtaining an extension of their hearing until March 25, 1970, but have not been successful in having the hearing put off entirely. As before, we would appreciate your letting us know if there might be any problem with this matter, so that we may protect the interests of our client, Federal Insurance Company.

We also note that you sent a copy of your letter of February 5, 1970, to Dr. Robert T. Smith at 2626 Adams Street, Denver, Colorado. For your information, the address we have for
