Comes now Cactus Drilling Corporation of Texas, and applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for approval of an extension of the pool boundaries of the North Baum-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool to include the southwest quarter of Section 17, Township 13 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and for approval of an unorthodox well location 1651 feet from the west line, and 330 feet from the south line of said Section 17, and in support thereof would show the Commission:

- 1. Applicant has drilled a well located at a point 1651 feet from the West line and 330 feet from the South line of Section 17, Township 13 South, Range 33 East.
- 2. Said well, on the notice of intention to drill, was inadvertently listed as being an extension of the Lazy J-Pennsylvanian pool, and its location was approved as such, when in fact it is located closer to, and is completed in the same formation as the North Baum-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, and should be included in that pool.
- 3. Under the pool rules for the North Baum-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, wells are required to be located on a tract consisting of 160 acres, more or less, comprising a governmental quarter section, with the well to be located within 150 feet of the center of any quarter-quarter section or lot within such unit.

WHEREFORE applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before the Commission or the Commission's duly appointed examiner, and that after notice and hearing as required by law the Commission enter its order extending the boundaries of the North Baum-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool to include the tract upon which applicant's well is located, and for the approval of an unorthodox well location for said well.
