This well is located 1,650 from the north line and 1653 feet from the west line of Section 11, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, in Eddy County.

The regulations require that the well be located 1,950 feet from the end boundaries of the unit in the

west half of Section 11, and the unit for this well, therefore, is 330 feet over the pattern. MR. GROSS: Just for the record, Mr. Examiner, this well has been renamed and it is now called the Malco "S" Federal Well Number 1. 5 (By Mr. Gross) You were describing the plat? 6 This shows two other wells in addition to the subject A 7 well. 8 What would the cost for drilling this well be? 9 The total cost would be \$216,500. 10 And you are not requesting a nonstandard unit? 11 No, this is a standard unit in the west half of 12 Section 11. This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on February 16, 1972, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Elvis A. Uts.

NOW, on this 28th day of February, 1972, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Amoco Production Company, seeks an exception to Rule 104 of the Commission Rules and Regulations for approval of an unorthodox gas well location for its Malco "S' Federal Well Ko. 1, located 1650 feet from the North line and 1653 feet from the West line of Section 11, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, undesignated Morrow-Pennsylvanian Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the subject well was projected as a wildcat oil well at a standard location to test the Mississippian formation but was productive of gas from the Morrow formation.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the subject undesignated Morrow-Pennsylvanian

pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

- (2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
