

#### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 16, 1972, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 22nd day of February, 1972, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation of Buena Suerte-Pennsylvanian Oil Pool. It was completed in the Pennsylvanian formation on July 28, 1971. The top of the perforations is at 10,956 feet.

MR. HATCH: Northwest New Mexico nomenclature case calling for an order for the creation and extension of certain pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba, McKinley and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico.

#### A. R. KENDRICK,

was called as a witness and, having been already duly sworn, testified as follows:

#### DIRECT EXAMINATION

#### BY MR. HATCH:

- Q Will you identify yourself for the record, please?
- A A. R. Kendrick, Engineer with the New Mexico Oil
  Conservation Commission in District III.

MR. HATCH: I think the record will show that Mr. Kendrick has already been sworn.

MR. UTZ: Let the record show that this is the same Mr. Kendrick that testified in the previous Case.

- Q (By Mr. Hatch) Are you prepared to make recommendations to the Examiner creating extensions to certain pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba, McKinley and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico?
- A Yes, sir.
- Q Are your recommendations prepared in the form of an Exhibit?
- A Yes, I have one Exhibit which includes all the

paragraphs advertised, and I have some other information that might be submitted, but not in the form of an Exhibit.

- Q Is the Docket that has been distributed that includes paragraphs (a) through (bb) the same as your Exhibit?
- A My Exhibit is in the same order relating to the new field and the acreage involved and the expansion and is in the same order as the paragraphs shown in the Docket.
- And do I understand correctly that you do not want to discuss paragraph (d) of that, at the present time, but you would like to go ahead with paragraphs (a) through (bb) and leave paragraph (d) and come back to it?
- A Yes.
- Q Would you refer to your Exhibit 1 and paragraphs (a) through (bb) and point out to the Commissioner any differences between -- or differences that need to be added or taken away?

MR. UTZ: Is this as compared to the Docket that has been distributed?

MR. HATCH: Yes.

A I would like to discmiss for further study paragraph (g) which deals with the Snake Eyes-Dakota Oil Pool in Township 21 North, Range 8 West.

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Is that paragraph (g) as in George. The wells in the pool are currently undergoing production tests to determine whether this is a gas pool or an oil pool.

In paragraph (j) the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool, I would like to add Township 26 North, Range 9 West, Section 15, in the northwest quarter and Section 16.

In paragraph (k), telating to the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, I would like the following added: Township 31 North, Range 12 West, Section 27, the north half, and Section 28, the north half and the southeast quarter.

- Excuse me, did you say Section 12? Q
- No, sir, Range 12 West, Sections 27 and 28.
- Go ahead. Q

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In paragraph (o) the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs A Pool, I would like to add: Township 25 North Range 4 West, Section 2, the west half, Section 3, all, and Section 4, all. Also Township 26 North, Range 4 West, Section 35, the southwest quarter.

Paragraph (x) relates to the Otero-Chacra Pool. Delete: Township 25 North, Range 6 West, Section 6, the northeast quarter.

In Paragraph (y), relating to the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool, I would like to add Township 24 North, Range 5

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West, Section 10, the northwest quarter and the southwest quarter.

In paragraph (z), relating to the Pinon-Fruitland Pool, I would like to delete Township 28 North, Range 12 West, Section 13, the southwest quarter and Section 14, the southeast quarter and replace that with Township 28 North, Range 11 West, Section 19 of the west half.

- Mr. Kendrick, your Exhibit 1 contains additions to the Docket concerning the well upon which you based your extensions and deletions; doesn't it?
- Yes, the name of the operator or the name and number of the well, and location, and its initial potential so far as it was known for each well completed within the acreage is listed in Exhibit 1.
- Q Do you have anything further except for paragraph (d) that you would like to present at this time?
- A No, sir.
- Would you turn to paragraph (d) -- you have some other Exhibits to present concerning paragraph (d); do you not?
- A I have some other information that might be presented in the form of Exhibits or not, it is information that would clarify any discussion on paragraph (d).
- Q Would you go through each of those Exhibits for the

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Examiner, pointing out what they contain and the purpose of the Exhibits, please?

- The first of these would be a history of the well operating in the area which I may have overlooked.
- This would be marked Exhibit 2?
- Yes, this would be Exhibit 2 in this Case. It merely relates to some of the operations in the area wherein the original wells were completed.

These two zones were dual completitions in December of 1964, by Order R-D-28-24. The Applicant, Continental Oil Company, received approval for downhole commingling in unit J of Section 28, subject to a Rehearing in June of 1965.

The Rehearing was actually held in August of 1965 -- excuse me, the Order was signed in August wherein Order R-224 was to remain in effect provided annual tests be taken to determine the zones allowable information and productivity of the Gallup-Dakota zone.

On October 13th, Order R-2978 provided for the Continental Oil Company administrative approval procedure for downhole commingling in the Gallup-Dakota Pool in Rio Arriba County.

The Application required that the Commission be provided with semi-annual tests until annual tests

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were approved on October 3, 1968, in a letter from the Secretary-Director of the Commission to the Continental Oil Company, and it approved Continental's request to replace the dual flow downhole commingling required by Order 2978.

Administrative Orders were issued on September 6, 1970, September 20, 1970, and on September 28, 1970, for the wells in the area identified with their legal description as contained in paragraph (d) of this Case.

On December 1, 1970, Order R-4071 approved Continental's Application for downhole commingling for four undrilled wells in this area with the allowable assignment based on the average production factors from the then completed downhole wells or the history of the production of the wells in the area.

These factors were set out at fifty-three percent of the oil and thirty-nine percent of the gas in the Gallup zone and forty-seven percent of the oil and sixteen percent of the gas in the Dakota zone.

On October 8, 1971, Order R-4302 approved Continental's Application for downhole commingling for two additional wells to be drilled after the Hearing and it set out the same allocation factors as were assigned in Order R-4071. This Order also set out administrative approval of undrilled wells to

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be completed in like manner and the same allocation factors.

On December 30, 1971, a downhole commingling Order, DIC-102 was issued approving downhole commingling for five new wells, yet to be drilled at that time.

On January 27, 1972, Order 4245 approved the Application of Manning Oil and Gas Company for downhole commingling on the Apache 100 Well, located in Section 3 which offset one of the wells included in this Case today.

The allowable factors were the same as in Order R-4302.

- Would you say that most of the wells in the area described by paragraph (d) are being commingled at the well bore?
- All of the wells completed in either the Gallup or Dakota zone in the area, are downhole commingled except two.
- Do you have anything further you want to add in addition to Exhibit 2?
- Λ No.

Exhibit 3 is the area plat of this acreage and, as the numbers show, these are forty acre tracts and the Order Number for each is shown. Those colored in solid green were issued prior to the time gas was

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considered in the allocation formula.

Those colored in light blue are wells approved by Order R-4071. Those in dark blue were approved by Order R-4302.

The two wells colored in orange are completed with parallel casing string and are not yet downhole commingled.

One well in the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 22 is colored in solid green and this is one of the wells approved by Administrative Order DHC-102 and has the same allowable factor as those wells colored in blue.

- Mr. Kendrick, the different colors on here represent different Orders, either Administrative or otherwise, and they also really represent different allocation factors as far as oil and gas to the zones are concerned?
- A Yes.
- Q And they are scattered throughout the entire area?
- A Yes, principally along the northwest edge of the outlined area and the southeast corner of the outlined area.
- Q Have you determined how it was allocated, on what basis?
- A As to those Administrative Orders?

percentage assignment to the upper zone and lower

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zone and it shows from Exhibit 7 of the Applicant's Application Form, the test data showing the amount of oil and the amount of oil produced during that month from each of the zones.

I have calculated these amounts of oil in percentages and this shows that although the depletion curve summary may be right in the long term, that these assignments of percentages, do not necessarily fit the current production percentages.

For example, if you will refer to DHC-60, the upper zone was sixty percent while, in testing during July of 1970, that well produced slightly over fourteen percent.

- Excuse me, fourteen percent would have been the Q production before it was commingled?
- This is true.
- Continue. Q
  - One other case is DHC-66, and the allocation for production was fifty-five percent for the upper zone while the actual upper zone allowable produced was less than forty-five percent.

So our current allocations do not fit our current production percentages.

- Will you identify Exhibit 5 for the Commissioner? Q
- Exhibit 5 is a production summary for all these

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wells inside the outlined area or legal description of the proposed pool.

The first column on the left is the lease
number; the second column is the well number; and
immediately following, is the unit letter and section
number. Then to the right of that wide space is the
downhole commingling approval order number as referred
to on the prior Exhibits.

Column one is the tabulation and shows the cumulative volume produced by each zone for each well through December 31, 1970.

The top line of each well relates to the shallow zone of the Gallup formation. The second line for each well relates to the Dakota formation. In column two of the tabulation you will find the percentage of production by each zone.

On the left-hand side is the percentage of production through 1970, the percentage of what is shown in column one and the percentage of production on the right-hand side of the column shows the percentage during 1971.

Mr. Kendrick, may I interrupt you a minute? If you would take J-22 and then go through what the numbers relate to, whether it is either the Gallup or the Dakota zone, and give the actual numbers, I think then

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that the Commissioner will know what these numbers are for.

All right. Twenty-two is the lease number; one is the well number, and J-22 is the first well on the page. It had a cumulative production through December 31, 1970 in the Gallup zone of 26,030, or seventy-six percent of the production of the well.

The Dakota zone produced 8,447 barrels or twenty-four percent of production from that well during 1971.

After downhill commingling, the Gallup zone was to have produced 1,500 barrels, or fifty-eight percent and the Dakota zone was to have produced 1,066 barrels or forty-two percent.

- May I interrupt you for just one minute? This well is not commingled; is it?
- A No, excuse me, this well was not commingled.
- All right, now, would you take any other particular well you want to point out on this Exhibit and go through it?
- A On Tabulation line twenty-five, the lease number is twenty-eight, the well number is seven. The history of that well shows that the Gallup zone produced thirty-six percent of its oil through 1970, by the allocation formula in Order DHC-60. During 1971

sixty percent of production was attributed to the Gallup zone.

On line twenty-one, lease number 28 and well number 5, during 1970, production was reported at forty-two percent in the Gallup, but during 1971, there was sixty percent attributed to the Gallup and that was through downhill commingling Order DHC-58.

I think this Exhibit shows that our record keeping is not exactly accurate for the production rates at the present time.

I think the operator would be better off
administratively if we combined this into one pool
known as the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool,
with certain vertical limits to be from the base
of the Dakota production interval upwards through the
Gallup formation and we declared this one common source
of supply.

If I understand your testimony, you are testifying
that practically all of the wells now in the area
are commingled in those two zones and that under various
Commission Orders certain production has been
attributed to various zones, but it isn't accurately
reflected as to where the production is coming from?
True. Some of the allocations are based on history
and some are based on the projections of the decline curve.

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and lower zones. I don't think you have testified as to what you expect in the future. Do you expect for wells that are drilled in the future, for the operator to ask for commingling in the wells for these two zones, or do you expect the operator to come in with single completions? In looking at the productivity of this area, it would not be economical to complete a single Gallup or a single Dakota well, so they will be asking for

Were Exhibits 1 through 5 prepared by you?

Yes, sir.

MR. HATCH: I would like to move the introduction of Exhibits 1 through 5.

MR. UTZ: Without objection, they will be entered into the record of this case.

> (Whereupon Exhibits 1 through 5 were admitted in evidence.)

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MR. UTZ: And you are recommending cumulative production for both zones?

THE WITNESS: Yes, lump all production in one and declare it all one pool.

MR. UTZ: Is there any great difference in pressure in these two zones?

THE WITNESS: No. If you will refer to line fifteen on Exhibit 4, lease number twenty-eight, well number 2 --

MR. UTZ: I think that is Exhibit Number 5.

THE WITNESS: Exhibit 5. If you will look at line fifteen, this well is not commingled and no Gallup production has been recorded since March of 1966.

Possibly the Dakota would help the Gallup produce and salvage what oil is there.

MR. UTZ: Any further questions?
(No response.)

MR. UTZ: If not, the witness may be excused.

(Witness excused.)

MR. UTZ: Any statements?

MR. PARR: I am Charles Parr with Continental
Oil Company and I would like to make a short statement.

MR. UTZ: You may proceed.

MR. PARR: Continental Oil Company highly recommends that you approve forming this pool. We further

recommend that, if possible, this pool be expanded to include another 960 acres.

We have logged a well called Thirty, Number Five, in the northwest quarter of Section 32, Township 25 North, Range 4 West; we have drilled a well called Thirty, Number Six, in the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 29, of the same township; and we have drilled a well called Twenty, Number Two in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 20 in the same township.

Wells have also been drilled -- Well Twenty-two,

Number Seven, in the northeast quarter of Section Theand

we propose, if this is possible, that in addition to the

land outlined by Mr. Kendrick, the pool should include

the northeast -- pardon me, I will start from a different area.

In Section 21, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, we would include the northeast quarter and the southeast quarter in Section 20, and include the southeast quarter in Section 29 including the east halves of Sections 29 and 32 in the northeast quarter.

There are an additional 960 acres in each case.

These wells have penetrated the Gallup-Dakota

zones and one of them was drilled on Friday, the Thirty,

Number Five.

I have information on testing and Well Twenty-two,
Number Seven, was finalized and Continental reported it on

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February 5, 1970, as being commingled and it showed thirty-six percent oil and 196 MCF of gas.

Our Number Seven Well, in Section 21 -- the Number Five Well, showed in a report of February 5, 1972, that it made forty-seven percent oil and 490 MCF of gas.

MR. KENDRICK: All these wells you have mentioned, are those approved and shown in my plat as outlined in green by Administrative Order DHC-102?

MR. PARR: Yes.

MR. HATCH: Mr. Parr, I think this is outside of the advertising on this Case, however, I think all of this would be within the one pool and would be governed by this and would come up at the next nomenclature Hearing.

MR. PARR: We do have four leases and you can see that in most of the areas there is nobody within a half a mile (indicating).

MR. HATCH: I think Mr. Kendrick could make an addition here, if he so desired.

MR. KENDRICK: I think Mr. Parr stated that he wanted the northeast quarter in Section 21?

MR. PARR: The southwest -- the northeast and southwest, I was reading it wrong, the northeast and southwest.

MR. KENDRICK: I have no objection to bringing these additions into the pool at the present time.

MR. UTZ: What paragraph would this be?

Dear Pete:

I advertised in the subject case to establish the West Lindrith-Gallup Dakota Oil Pool.

The rumors I heard in the office in Santa Fe indicated some internal objection to the area being treated as a single pool.

The area was advertised at an earlier hearing, but due to an error in the legal ad the paragraph was deleted from the order.

It is my opinion that the staff should present a single position in each case before the public.

The enclosed plat shows the pool outline proposed and all wells currently producing in the pool with the approved order for each well with down-hole commingling.

The exhibits in Case 4462 presented by Continental Oil Company show that the reservoir is a stratigraphic trap without known abrupt changes.

In Case 4646 heard January 19, 1972, the applicant asked for similar commingling of the production in Section 3, just south of this area.

The Continental Oil Company is the operator of all the acreage within the proposed pool boundary.

The only objections I have heard are: I. keeping production records by zones, and 2. the unknown horizontal limits of the pool.

In my opinion the production records by zones are not accurate; because, we have approved the use of averages for zone assignments. As far as the unknown horizontal limits, this pool is similar to every other pool being developed.

If the decision is to vacate this paragraph at this time, I would appreciate learning of it prior to the preparation of my exhibit.







#### IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

(1) That, pursuant to Section 65-3-14.5, NMSA 1953, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which, by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.

(2) That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be March 1, 1972.
