8 Deep Well was drilled as a wildcat, and was an orthodox 40-acre Devonian oil well drilled to a total depth of 10 11,050 feet into the upper Missippippian line, at which 11 point it was decided that its structural position did not warrant going onto the Devonian sub. The well reached a total depth of 11,050 feet on 12/31/71. Open 13 hole electric logs were run to the total depth. On 15 Exhibit B, you will find the drill stem tests intervals. It was drill seem tested from 10,675 to 10,695 with 2.347 17 MCF per day. It was perforated at 10,376 to 13,894, and completed on 2/4/72 with 6,400,000 cubic feet of gas 18 per/day. 19 And what is the present status of the well? 20 The well is presently shut in waiting for a pipe line 21 22 connection. Now, you have shown on Exhibit A an area outlined in 0 23 24 red. What is the significance of that outline?

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on March 1, 1972, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 15th day of March, 1972, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Hanagan Petroleum Corporation, seeks an exception to Rule 104 of the Commission Rules and Regulations for approval of an unorthodox gas well location for its Millman Deep Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the Morth line and 1924 feet from the East line of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, undesignated Morrow gas pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the subject well was projected as an oil well to test the Devonian formation but was productive of gas from the Morrow formation.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable

share of the gas in the subject undesignated Morrow gas pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved for the Hanagan Petroleum Corporation's Millman Deep Well No. 1 in an undesignated Morrow gas pool at a point 660 feet from the North line and 1924 feet from the East line of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, as an exception to Rule 104 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.



CASE 4670: Application of BTA Oil Producers for a special gasoil ratio limitation, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks as an exception to Rule 506 of the Commission Rules and Regulations, a limiting gas-oil ratio of 10,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil for the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool,

Lea County, New Mexico.
