11 DIRECT EXAMINATION

12 BY MR. KELLY:

13 Q Would you state your name, by whom you are employed,  
 14 and your position?

15 A Curtis Cook, Production Engineer for Texaco, Inc., in  
 16 Hobbs, New Mexico.

17 Q Have you previously qualified as an expert witness in  
 18 the field of Petroleum Engineering before the Commission?

19 A Yes, I have.

20 Q Referring to the plat which has been marked as Applicant's  
 21 Exhibit Number 1, would you briefly state what Texaco  
 22 seeks by this Application?

23 A Exhibit 1 is a plat of the area indicating the Texaco  
 24 V. M. Henderson Well Number 9 and we seek permission to  
 25 dually complete this well in the Paddock and Tubb zones.

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- 1 Q What is the history of this well and its present
- 2 status?
- 3 A The well was drilled in 1962 and there were three
- 4 strings of two and three inch casing run. It was
- 5 cemented back to about 2,500 feet and was completed
- 6 in the Grayburg-Paddock zones.
- 7 Q Was that the Paddock and Tubb zones?
- 8 A Right. The Grayburg had been shut in.
- 9 Q What is the present production from the two zones?
- 10 A The Paddock zone is producing about ten barrels a day
- 11 and the Tubb zone is flowing seventeen barrels of oil
- 12 a day.
- 13 Q Referring you to what has been marked Applicant's Exhibit
- 14 Number 2, would you explain the installation Texaco
- 15 has for the well?
- 16 A A string surface pipe -- three strings of 2 & 3/8 inch
- 17 casing cemented and centralized through all of the zones.
- 18 Q Do you feel that the casing and cementing shown in
- 19 Exhibit 2 effectively reflect the separation of the
- 20 zones?
- 21 A Yes.
- 22 Q Exhibit Number 3 is a log of the well, would you point
- 23 out the various zones?
- 24 A The Penrose is indicated at about 3,700 feet and then
- 25 the Paddock at 5,150; the Tubb at 6,200 and then down

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1 at 6,600 is the abandoned Drinker zone.

2 Q Have you notified all of the operators of offset wells  
 3 of this Application?

4 A Yes, we have.

5 Q In your opinion, would the granting of this Application  
 6 have any adverse affect on the correlative rights of the  
 7 other operators?

8 A No.

9 Q Would the granting of this Application prevent waste?

10 A It would enable us to produce the reserves in this area  
 11 which otherwise would not be produced.

12 Q Were Exhibits 1 through 3 prepared by you or under your  
 13 supervision?

14 A Yes.

15 MR. KELLY: I move for the introduction of  
 16 Texaco Exhibits 1 through 3.

17 MR. UTZ: Without objection, Exhibits 1 through 3  
 18 will be entered into the record.

19 (Whereupon Texaco's Exhibits 1 through 3 were

NOW, on this 11th day of May, 1972, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Texaco Inc., seeks authority to complete its V. M. Henderson Well No. 9, located in Unit G of Section 30, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (tubingless) to produce oil from the Paddock and Tubb Pools through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch casing, cemented in a common well-bore.

(3) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.

(4) That approval of the subject application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Texaco Inc. is hereby authorized to complete its V. M. Henderson Well No. 9, located in Unit G of Section 30, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (tubingless) to produce oil from the Paddock and Tubb Pools through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch casing, cemented in a common well-bore.

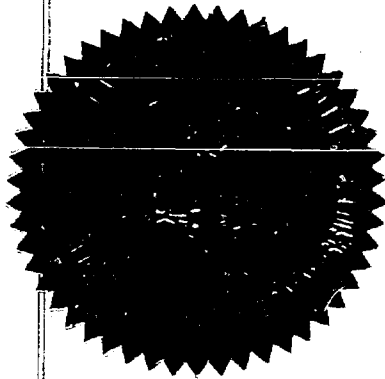

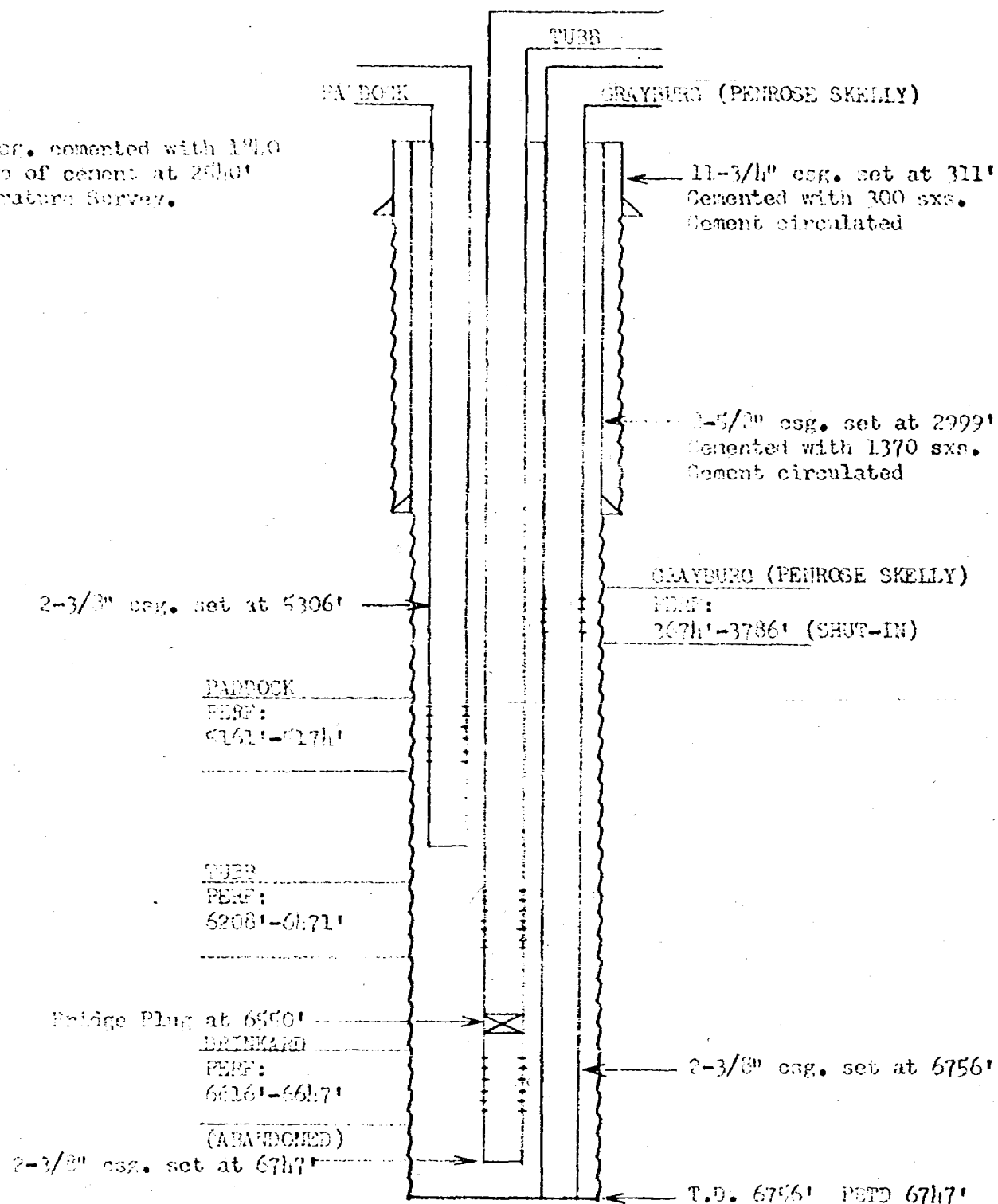

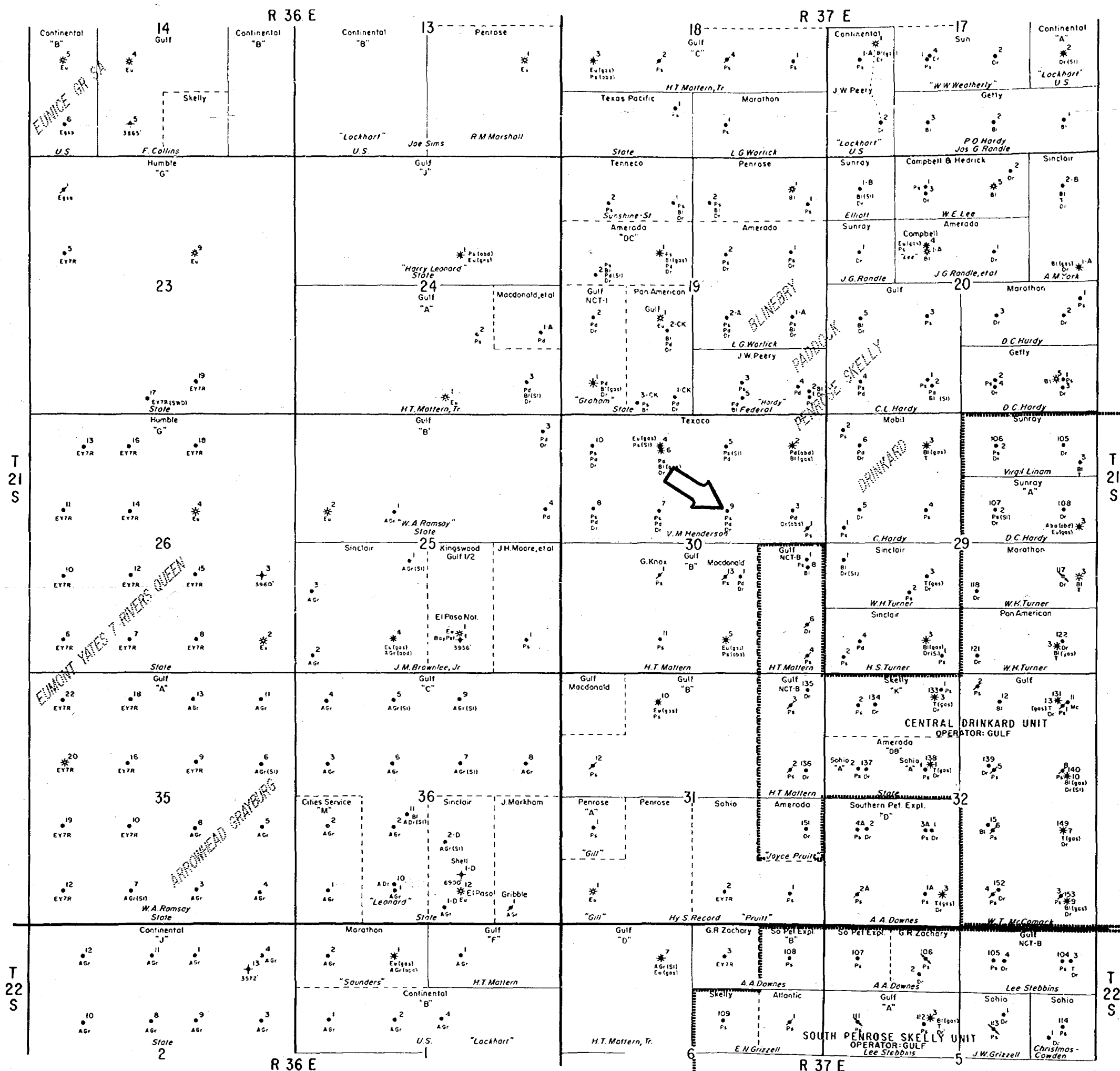
