



COMES now Sun Oil Company and applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for approval of an unorthodox well location in the Crossroads Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show the Commission:

- 1. Applicant is the owner of the right to drill and develop the oil and gas minerals in the area involved in this application.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill a well, U-D Sawyer Well #10, to the Crossroads Devonian Pool at a location of 1,000.5 feet from the East line and 986 feet from the South line of Section 27, Township 9 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
- 3. A well located as proposed will prevent waste, is in the interests of conservation, and the correlative rights of no offset operators will be impaired.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that his application be set for hearing before the Commission or the Commission's duly appointed examiner, and that after notice and hearing as required by

law the Commission enter its order approving the location as prayed for.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on November 29 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this day of December , 1972, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Sun Oil Company, seeks authority to drill its proposed U. D. Sawyer Well No. 10 at an unorthodox location 986. Ifeet from the South line and 1000.5 feet from the East line of Section 27, Township 9 South, Range 36 East, Siluro Devonian
 Crossroads Devonian
 Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That said location varies from a standard location by 8% feet and is farther from situated more distant from acreage of offsetting operators than standard locations.

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That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That an unorthodox oil well location for the Devonian formation is hereby approved for the Sun Oil Company U. D. Sawyer Well No. 10, to be located 986. feet from the South line and 1000.5 feet from the East line of Section 27, Township 9 South, Siluro Devonian Range 36 East, NMPM, Crossroads Devenian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (2) That the SE/438/4 of said Section 27 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.
- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
