TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

1 MR. UTZ: Case 4883: Application of El Paso
2 Natural Gas Company for non-standard gas spacing units, San
3 Juan County, New Mexico.

4 MR. MORRIS: Mr. Examiner, I am Dick Morris, of
5 the firm of Montgomery, Federici, Hannahs, Andrews and Morris,
6 Santa Fe, appearing on behalf of the Applicant. We have two
7 witnesses, Mr. Higgins and Mr. Brown. I ask that they stand
8 and be sworn.

9 MR. UTZ: Let me ask for other appearances at this
10 time.

11 (No response)

12 MR. UTZ: There appear to be none.

13 CHARLES HIGGINS,
14 was called as a witness, and after being duly sworn, testified
15 as follows:

16 DIRECT EXAMINATION

17 BY MR. MORRIS:

18 Q Will you state your name and where you reside, please?

19 A Charles Higgins, and I reside at 1804 Chouctau Avenue,
20 Farmington, New Mexico.

21 Q By whom are you employed, and in what capacity?

22 A Regional land manager for El Paso Natural Gas Company
23 for the Northwest region.

24 Q Would you briefly state your education, and experience
25 in the petroleum industry?

1 A Yes. I have a bachelor of science degree in business
2 administration, and also a law degree from the
3 University of South Dakota. I graduated in 1957, and
4 I have been employed by El Paso Natural Gas Company
5 since that time in their land department. I have been
6 in my present position of regional land planner for
7 a year and a half. Prior to that time, I supervised
8 land planning for approximately six years in the home
9 office in El Paso. Prior to that, I was district land
10 planner in Marrietta, Ohio, and I was area coordinator
11 for that area.

12 Q Are you familiar with El Paso Natural Gas Company's
13 application in Case 4883?

14 A Yes, sir.

15 Q Referring to Exhibit Number One in this case, Mr.
16 Higgins, will you explain what that plat shows and what
17 El Paso is seeking by this application?

18 A Yes, sir. Due to variations of legal subdivisions of
19 public land surveys, the quarter sections along the
20 western boundary of Township 31 North, 9 West are
21 irregular in size. As you will note from the plat,
22 these quarter sections vary in size between approximately
23 96 and 104 acres. I think the average is approximately
24 100 acres. Because of this irregularity, we are
25 unable to form standard 160-acre gas proration units

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1 for the drilling of the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs wells
2 in this area. For that reason, we are asking the
3 Commission to approve four non-standard gas proration
4 units as depicted on the plat. These vary in size
5 from 145.64 acres, and increase in size to 152.63 acres.

6 By the formation of these units, we can at least
7 approximate the standard 160-acre proration unit for
8 the area for Pictured Cliffs drilling.

9 Q Is the exact legal description of all of these units
10 the same as set forth on the docket in this case?

11 A Yes, sir.

12 Q What is the nearest designated Pictured Cliffs pool?

13 A The Blanco-Pictured Cliffs would be the nearest.

14 Q Mr. Brown will testify in more detail concerning this,
15 but Mr. Higgins, just generally what is El Paso's
16 proposal for the development of these non-standard
17 units?

18 A At the present time, we have a well scheduled for the
19 Southwest quarter of Section 31, which will be in
20 Tract 1. This is the only actual location, or well,
21 on these non-standard sites. We also have a well
22 scheduled for the Southeast of Section 31, and likewise
23 for the Northwest of Section 36. These are scheduled
24 for our 1973 drilling program. In addition, within
25 the next ten days, we will commence a well in the

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1 Southwest of Section 6, 31, 10.

2 MR. UTZ: That's the location shown on Exhibit One?

3 THE WITNESS: Yes, the one in the Southwest shows
4 1972, and then you will note that in the Northeast, we show
5 1973. Then also the two wells in Section 31 are designated
6 as 1973 wells.

7 Q (By Mr. Morris) Will the drilling of these wells bring
8 this acreage into the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool just
9 as a matter of the regular extension of that pool?

10 A It certainly would bring some in, I don't know how far
11 north it would go, but it certainly would bring in the
12 non-standard gas proration units.

13 Q You are not asking that the Commission, at this time,
14 re-designate this acreage by nomenclature?

15 A No, sir.

16 Q The acreage that you have asked be designated as
17 non-standard units comprises what would amount to the
18 West half of each of these sections, or together,
19 all four non-standard units would be in the West half
20 of Sections 19, 30 and 31; is that correct?

21 A Yes, sir.

22 Q Now, is the East half of these sections regular?

23 A Yes, they are standard.

24 Q Has this acreage previously been-- let me start my
25 question again. Have non-standard units in other pools

1 been established in the same area that you were
2 asking these non-standard units be established for
3 the Pictured Cliffs production?

4 A Yes. For example, Tracts 1 and 2 are combined, and
5 have been under Order R-35, which was entered on
6 December 1st, 1950. Likewise, Tracts 3 and 4 are
7 included in Mesaverde proration units.

8 Q Would you review the ownership in these units?

9 A Yes, sir. In Tract 1, El Paso owns 75 percent, and
10 Claude Lamb owns 25 percent of that tract. In Tract
11 2, El Paso owns 91.7 percent, and Claude Lamb owns
12 8.3 percent. In Unit Number 3, El Paso owns 92.48
13 percent, and Forrest Miller, Mabel Miller, and Michael
14 Van's estate owns 7.6 percent. El Paso owns all of
15 Tract 4.

16 Q Now, the percentages that you have just given vary
17 somewhat from the information shown on the plan. Would
18 you explain that?

19 A Because of the Mesaverde communitization encompassing
20 both Tracts 1 and 2. Under this communitization for
21 those tracts, all formations from the surface to the
22 base of the Mesaverde were communitized. Because of
23 that, Mr. Lamb will share ownership in Tracts 1 and 2,
24 and El Paso will have the remaining share of the wells
25 drilled on either one of those two tracts.

1 Q Mr. Higgins, will approval of this application serve
2 in the best interest of conservation and the protection
3 of correlative rights?

4 A Yes, it will.

5 Q Was Exhibit One prepared by you, or under your direction?

6 A Yes, sir.

7 MR. MORRIS: At this time, we offer Exhibit One
8 into evidence.

9 MR. UTZ: Exhibit One will be entered into the
10 record of this case.

11 MR. MORRIS: That's all we have on direct
12 examination.

14 CROSS EXAMINATION

15 BY MR. KENDRICK:

16 Q Mr. Higgins, the acreage you requested be formed
17 encompasses all acreage-- all of the acreage is in the
18 West half of Section 19, Section 30, and Section 31?

19 A Yes, sir.

20 Q It does not leave out any tracts in the area?

21 A No, it encompasses all of the area.

22 MR. KENDRICK: I have no further questions.

23 MR. UTZ: Are there any other questions of the
24 witness?

25 (No response)

1 MR. UTZ: If not, the witness may be excused.
2 (Witness excused.)

4 CHARLES BROWN,
5 was called as a witness, and having been already duly sworn,
6 testified as follows:

7 DIRECT EXAMINATION

8 BY MR. MORRIS:

9 Q Will you please state your name and where you reside?

10 A Charles F. Brown, I reside at 1413 Camino, Farmington,
11 New Mexico.

12 Q By whom are you employed?

13 A I am employed as a senior geologist by El Paso Natural
14 Gas Company.

15 Q Would you briefly recite your education and experience
16 in the industry?

17 A I was graduated from Texas Western College, now known
18 as the University of Texas at El Paso, in 1951, with
19 a degree-- a bachelor of science degree in geology.
20 I then went to work for Rotary Engineering Company in
21 Texas in 1951. I worked for them until 1952, and then
22 in January, 1953, I went to work for El Paso in Midland.
23 I was transferred to Farmington a year later, where
24 I have been working for them since in the development
25 section of their geology department, primarily concerning

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1 myself with the development of the Pictured Cliffs
2 formation.

3 Q Now, are you familiar with El Paso Natural Gas Company's
4 application in this case?

5 A Yes, I am.

6 Q Have you prepared some exhibits in support of this
7 application?

8 A Yes, we have.

9 Q Would you please refer to what has been marked as
10 Exhibit Two, and explain that exhibit?

11 A The dotted section of Exhibit Two is the present
12 boundary of the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool. The green
13 dots indicate the wells we have drilled during 1972,
14 with the exception of one well in the Southwest of
15 Section 4, which was drilled by Amoco. The red dots
16 you see are proposed locations for our 1973 program.

17 Q Please refer to Exhibit Number Three, and explain it.

18 A Exhibit Three is an isopack map showing sand thickness
19 that we expect out of the Pictured Cliffs formation.
20 This map was constructed from mechanical logs and
21 electric logs from the area of the Mesaverde wells.
22 Our interpretation shows that the trend goes in a
23 northerly direction. We can expect somewhere between
24 thirty and fifty feet of sandstone from the Pictured
25 Cliffs formation, and we intend to proceed in this

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direction.

Q Based upon the interpretation shown on Exhibit Three, would you have an opinion as to whether the proposed non-standard units are, and will be, productive from the Pictured Cliffs formation?

A Yes, they will be.

Q Were Exhibits Two and Three prepared by you, or under your direction?

A Yes, they were prepared by me.

MR. MORRIS: At this time, we offer Exhibits Two and Three into evidence.

MR. UTZ: Without objection, Exhibits Two and Three will be entered into the record of this case.

MR. MORRIS: That's all the direct testimony we have.

MR. UTZ: Are there any questions of the witness?
(No response)

MR. UTZ: If not, the witness may be excused.
(Witness excused.)

MR. UTZ: Any statements in this case?
(No response)

MR. UTZ: The case will be taken under advisement.

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on December 19, 1972, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Elvis A. Utz.

NOW, on this 5th day of January, 1973, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, El Paso Natural Gas Company, seeks the establishment of the following non-standard gas proration units adjacent to the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Township 31 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico:

- (a) A 145.64-acre unit comprising Lots 9 and 10 and 15 through 18 of Section 31;
- (b) A 153.46-acre unit comprising Lots 14 through 17 of Section 30 and Lots 7 and 8 of Section 31;
- (c) A 156.49-acre unit comprising Lots 17 and 18 of Section 19 and Lots 6 through 9 of Section 30;
- (d) A 152.63-acre unit comprising Lots 7 through 10 and 15 and 16 of Section 19.

(3) That each of the proposed non-standard gas proration units is productive of gas.

(4) That each of the proposed non-standard gas proration units can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by the well to which it is to be dedicated.

(5) That approval of the proposed non-standard gas proration units will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the pool, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:



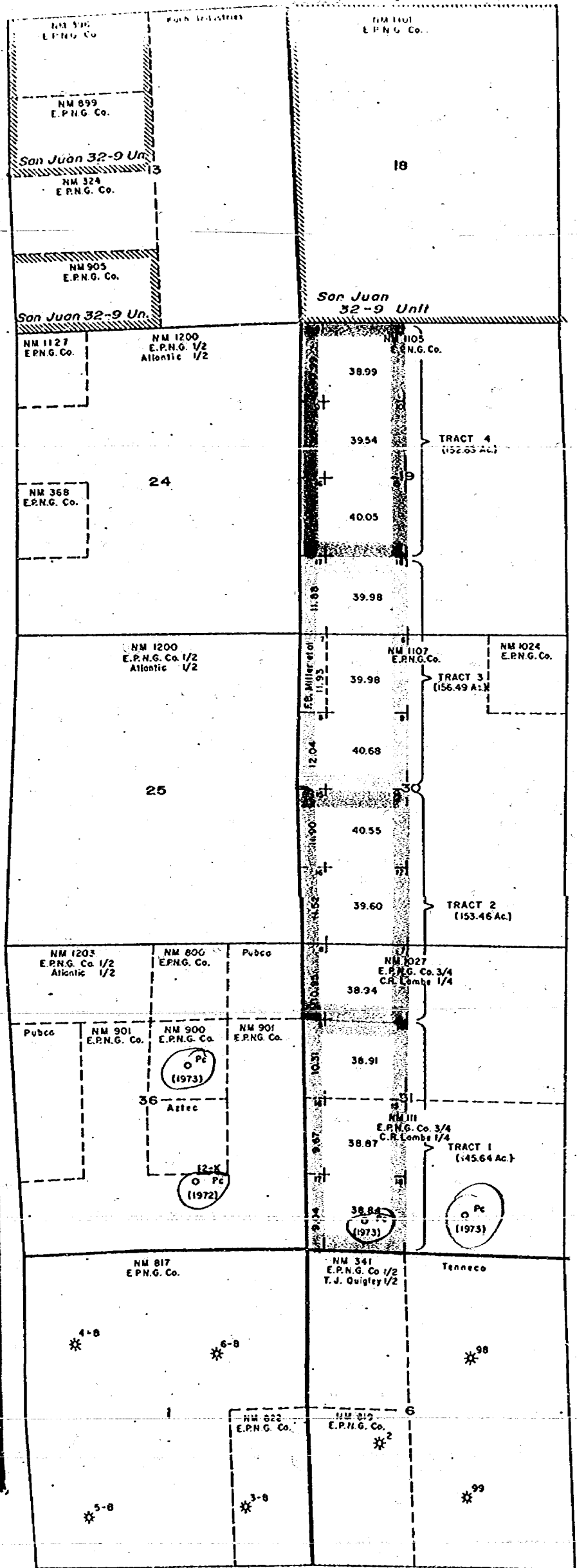

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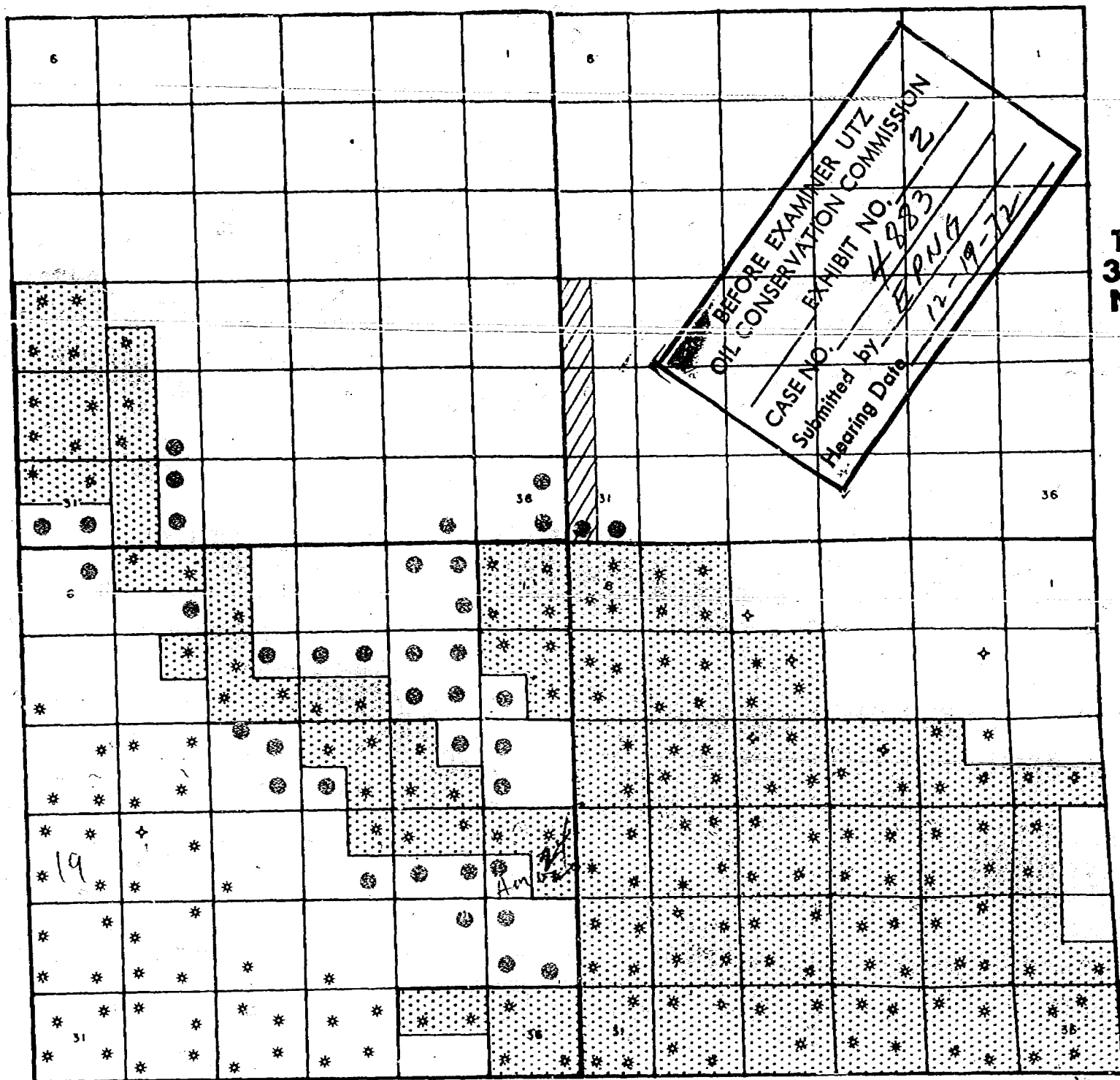

-Proposed locations for 1973



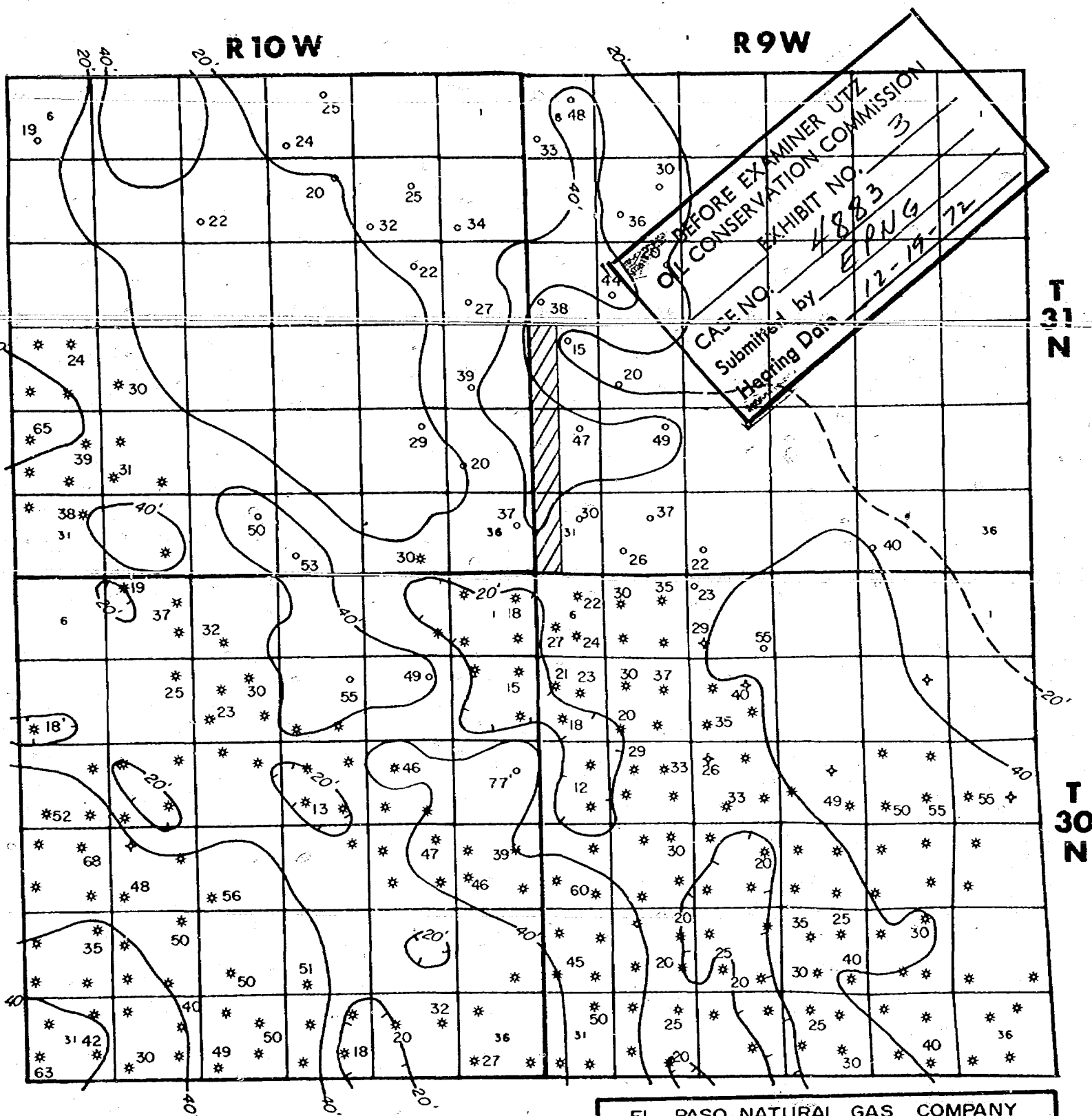

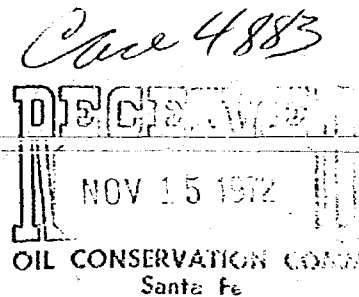

APPLICATION

Comes now El Paso Natural Gas Company, by its attorneys, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for the establishment of four nonstandard gas spacing units, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support of its Application states:

1. El Paso Natural Gas Company proposes the establishment of the following nonstandard gas spacing units for Pictured Cliffs production, all of said lands being located in Township 31 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico:

TRACT 1, comprising Lots 9, 10, 15, 16, 17 and 18 of Section 31, comprising 145.64 acres. ✓

TRACT 2, consisting of Lots 14, 15, 16 and 17 in Section 30 and Lots 7 and 8 in Section 31, comprising 153.46 acres. ✓

TRACT 3, consisting of Lots 17 and 18 in Section 19, and Lots 6, 7, 8 and 9 in Section 30, comprising 156.49 acres. ✓

TRACT 4, consisting of Lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 15 and 16 in Section 19, comprising 152.63 acres. ✓

2. Applicant is the owner and operator of the acreage contained in the aforesaid units with the following exceptions:

C. R. Lambe is the owner of a 16.5% working interest in Tracts 1 and 2 as described above.

Forrest B. Miller, M. M. Miller and Catherine B. McElvain are the owners of Lot 7 in Section 30, comprising a portion of Tract No. 3 as described above.

Applicant will seek to obtain voluntary commitment of these interests to the aforesaid units upon their being approved by the Commission.

3. The aforesaid nonstandard gas spacing units were previously approved and established as nonstandard units for purposes of Mesaverde production.

4. The lands contained in the aforesaid units are not located within the boundaries of any Pictured Cliffs pool as presently designated by the Commission. The Blanco Pictured Cliffs pool lies South of Tract 1 as herein described and is the closest Pictured Cliffs pool to the subject lands.

5. Approval of this Application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, the Applicant requests that this Application be set for hearing before the Commission or one of its Examiners and that the Commission enter its Order approving this Application.

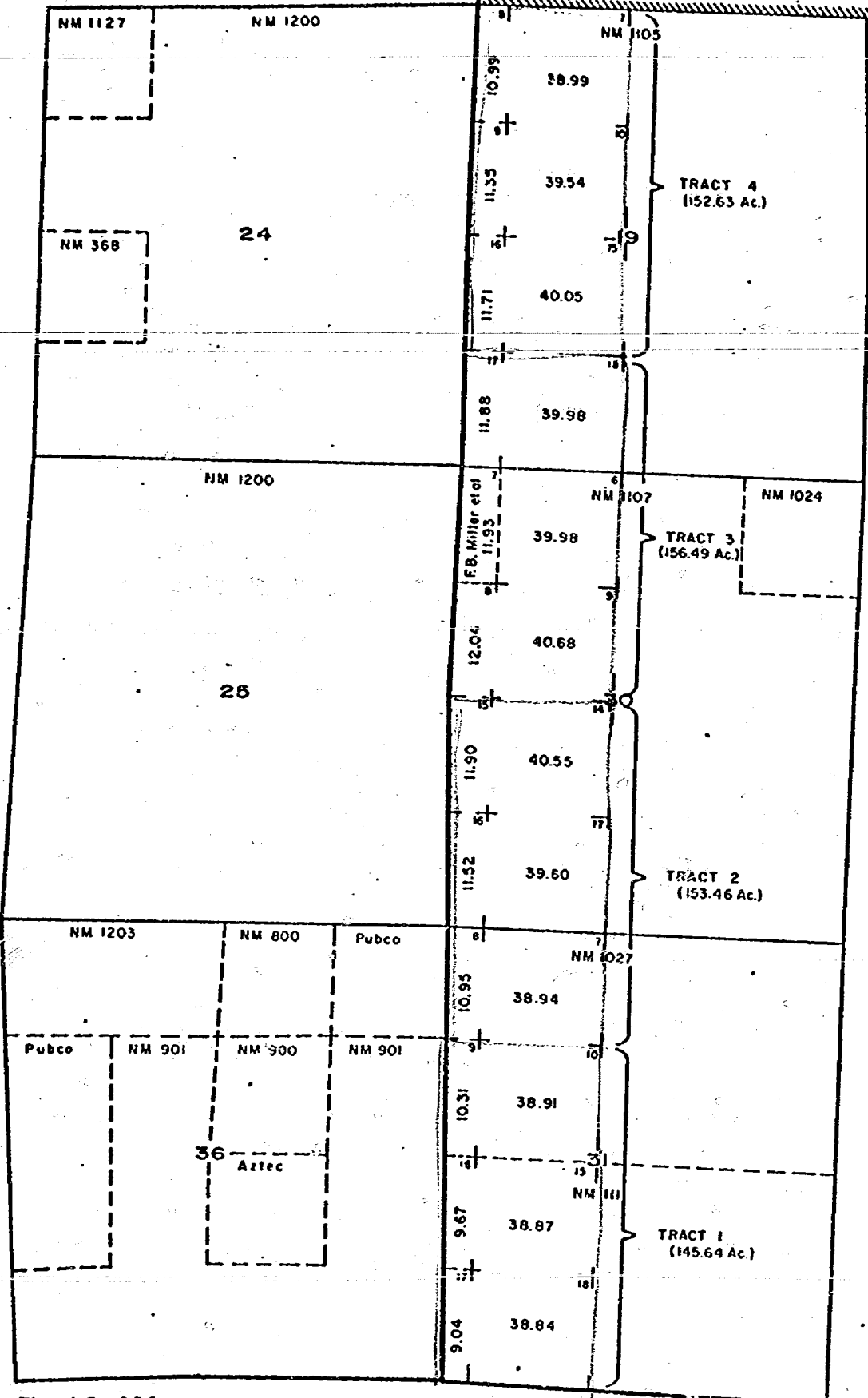

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(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
