



unit comprising the SW/4 NE/4 and the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 16 be dedicated to Well No. 4 and an 80-acre unit comprising the SW/4 SE/4 and SE/4 SW/4 dedicated to Well No. 5 to be drilled to a total depth of approximately 5750' at a standard location in Unit 0 760' FSL and 1890' FEL of Section 16.

- 3) The approval of this application is in the interest of providing for the recovery of oil which might otherwise not be recovered and protection of correlative rights.
- 4) Each offset operator on the attached list has been furnished a copy of this application.



ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on January 3, 1973 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter

NOW, on this day of January, 1973, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, seeks approval of two 80-acre non-standard oil proration units in the Fowler-Upper Yeso Pool, comprising the SW/4 NE/4 and NW/4 SE/4, and the SW/4 SE/4 and SE/4 SW/4 of Section 16, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to applicant's J. R. Holt (NCT-A) Well No. 4 located in Unit J and proposed JK, Holt (NCT-A) Well No. 5, to be located in Unit O, respectively, of said Section 16.

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- (3) That the proposed non-standard proration units can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by the subject wells.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That two 80-acre non-standard oil proration units in the Fowler-Upper Yeso Pool comprising the SW/4 NE/4 and NW/4 SE/4 and the SW/4 SE/4 and SE/4 SW/4 of Section 16, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, are hereby established and dedicated to the J. R. Holt (NCT-A) Well No. 4 located in Unit J and proposed, Well No. 5, to be located in Unit O, respectively, of said Section 16.
