CASE NO. 4914 Order No. R-4436

THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN EDDY, LEA AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on February 28, 1973, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Elvis A. Utz.

NOW, on this 2nd day of March, 1973, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new gas pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Morrow formation, said pool to bear the designation of Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool. Said Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool was discovered by the Monsanto Company, Burton Flat Deep Unit No. 1, located in Unit 0 of Section 3, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Morrow formation on November 3, 1972. The top of the perforations is at 11,308 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the San Andres formation, said pool to bear the designation of Lea-San Andres Pool. Said Lea-San Andres Pool was discovered by the Superior Oil Company Government "E" No. 2, located in Unit A of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. It was completed in the San Andres formation on November 29, 1972. The top of the perforations is at 5,855 feet.

- (4) That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation of South Peterson-Pennsylvanian Pool. Said South Peterson-Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by the Phillips Petroleum Company Goldston "A" No. 2, located in Unit P of Section 36, Township 5 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Pennsylvanian formation on November 18, 1972. The top of the perforations is at 7,706 feet.
- (5, That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Delaware formation, said pool to bear the designation of Triple X-Delaware Pool. Said Triple X-Delaware Pool was discovered by Hondo Drilling Company Gulf "NW" State No. 1, located in Unit M of Section 6, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Delaware formation on January 2, 1973. The top of the perforations is at 5,020 feet.
- (6) That there is need for certain extensions to the Anderson-Ennsylvanian Gas Pool, Boyd-Morrow Gas Pool, Fren-Seven Rivers Pool, Rock Tank Upper-Morrow Pool, and Rock Tank Lower-Morrow Pool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico; the Bell Lake-Bone Spring Pool, Blinebry Oil Pool, Cary-Montoya Pool, Maljamar-Grayburg San Andres Pool, West Sawyer-San Andres Pool, Tres Papalotes-Pennsylvanian Pool, North Vacuum-Abo Pool, North Vacuum-Morrow Gas Pool, and the Wantz-Abo Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico; and the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico.

Failure to file Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.
- (2) That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be March 1, 1973.

- (5) That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Delaware formation, said pool to bear the designation of Triple X-Delaware Pool. Said Triple X-Delaware Pool was discovered by Hondo Drilling Company Gulf "NW" State No. 1, located in Unit M of Section 6, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed the Delaware formation on January 2, 1973. The top of the perforations is at 5020 feet.

(6) That there is need for certain extensions to the Anderson-Pennsylvanian Pool, Boyd-Morrow Gas Pool, Fren-Seven Rivers Pool, Rock Tank Upper-Morrow Pool, and Rock Tank Lower-Morrow Pool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico; the Bell Lake-Bone Spring Pool, Blinebry-Oil Pool, Cary-Montoya Pool, Maljamar-Grayburg San Andres Pool, West Sawyer-San Andres Pool, Tres Papalotes-Pennsylvanian Pool, North Vacuum-Abo Pool, North Vacuum-Morrow Gas Pool, Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool, and the Wantz-Abo Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico; and the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

- (1) That, pursuant to Section 65-3-14.5, NMSA 1953, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which, by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.
- (2) That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be March 1, 1973.
