ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on July 2, 1981, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this _____ day of July, 1981, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Morrow formation, said pool to bear the designation of East Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool. Said East Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool was discovered by the Grace Petroleum Corporation West Tonto Federal Com Well No. 1 located in Unit L of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Morrow formation on January 5, 1981. The top of the perforations is at 13,502 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Mississippian formation, said pool to bear the designation of Peterson-Mississippian Pool. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.
- (2) That the effective date of this order and all creations, redesignations, and extensions included herein shall be August 1, 1981.
