ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on April 14, 1982, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this <u>28th</u> day of April, 1982, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That F. B. Umbarger, Trustee, is the owner and operator of the Davis Pooled Unit Well No. 1, located in Unit I of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) That said well has previously been plugged and abandoned but is currently leaking gas to the surface.



DIVISION APPROVED PLUGGING PROGRAM

F.B. Umbarger, Trustee Davis Pooled Unit #1 I-27-29N-!!W

- (1) Clean out hole to top of 5 1/2" casing stub at 960'.
- (2) Set cement plug from 960'-700' WOC at least 6 hours.
- (3) Go in hole with tubing and tag top of plug, if cement is 700' or above go to step 4. If cement is below 700' fill to 700'.
- (4) Set a cement plug 250'-50'. Watch fluid level for one hour. If fluid does not drop significantly go to step 5. If fluid level drops more than 20' WOC 6 hours and tag top of plug #2. If below 70' fill to 50'.



FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That F. B. Umbarger, Trustee, is the owner and operator of the Davis Pooled Unit Well No. 1, located in Unit I of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

(3) That Said well has previously been played and is the surety on the Cil abandom of but is currently her him yes to the surhere conservation Division plugging bond on which F. B. Unbarger, Trustee is principal.

That the purpose of said bond is to assure the state that the subject well will be properly plugged and abandoned when not capable of commercial production.

That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights said well should be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a program approved by the Aztec District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on or before

1982, or the well should be returned to active drilling status or placed on production.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That F. B. Umbarger is hereby ordered to plug and abandon the Davis Pooled Unit Well No. 1, located in Unit I of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, or in the alternative, to return the well to active drilling status or place the well on production on or before May 15, 1982.

(2) That F. B. Umbarger, Trustee, prior to plugging and abandoning the above-described well, shall obtain from the Aztec office of the Division, a Division-approved program for said plugging and abandoning, and shall notify said Aztec office of

the date and hour said work is to be commenced whereupon the Division may, at its option, witness such work.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
