



- 3. The requested unorthodox well location is needed to replace an offsetting well called the Wilson State #1 located 1980 feet from the West line and 660 feet from the North line of Section 19. The requested well will be sufficiently removed from the problem well to avoid the caving conditions

and the stuck well collars being experienced therein.

4. A well located as proposed will recover gas that would not otherwise be recovered, is in the interests of conservation, and will not impair the correlative rights of others.
