MR. PETERSON: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. Amoco will have one witness in this docket item, John Hunter. I would like the record to reflect that Mr. Hunter has been sworn and his qualifications accepted.

MR. NUTTER: He is still under oath.

### JOHN C. HUNTER

called as a witness, having been previously sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

### DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. PETERSON:

- Q Mr. Hunter, I direct your attention to an exhibit labeled Amoco's Exhibit One, would you explain what this exhibit shows, please?
- A. Exhibit Number One is a map showing completions in the Grayburg-Morrow Gas Pool and the South Empire-Morrow Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.
  - Q. I see you have markings on this exhibit and first of

all I direct your attention to the green and white tape which you enclosed an area with, would you explain what that area is

- A. The green and white striped tape outlines the boundary of Amoco's Empire South Deep Unit.
- Q. And within that Unit there is an area marked in red and white tape, what is that?
- A. The red and white tape marks the outline of a three-hundred-and-twenty-acre proration unit for the proposed Empire South Deep Unit No. 9. The proration unit consisting of the west half of Section 5, Township 18 South, Range 29 East.
- Q. And there is a red arrow directed into that area, would you tell us what that red arrow represents?
- A. The red arrow points to the proposed location of the Empire South Deep Unit No. 9. The location is an unorthodox location, being six hundred and sixty feet from the north line and nine hundred and ninety feet from the west line of Section 5.
- Q. Are all of the offset operators shown on this map, Mr. Hunter?
- A. All of the immediate offset operators to Section 5 are shown on the map.

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You propose to move the well in a northerly direction toward
the interior of the Empire South Deep Unit?

A. Yes, sir, it would be in an unorthodox location which would not crowd any offset operators.

Q. Do you have any further comments regarding Exhibit Ore?

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Q. All right, I would now like for you to look at Exhibit Two, Mr. Hunter, and tell us what that depicts?

A. Exhibit Number Two shows the eastern half of Amoco's Empire South Deep Unit, as well as the immediate offsetting acreage. On this map is shown a net pay isopach for the Morrow "A" sand. I would like to point out at this point that we realize that the Commission considers the Morrow sand as one single entitity for regulatory purposes but we have found that we can map separate and distinct lenses in the Morrow and this is one of them.

Q I see the markings on Exhibit Two correspond to the markings on Exhibit One?

A. Yes, insofar as the Unit boundary is concerned and the proration unit boundary and the designation of the surface location for No. 9.

Q In your opinion, Mr. Hunter, is the entire western

portion of Section 5 productive?

A. Yes, sir, it is obvious from this net pay isopach that all of the west half of Section 5 could reasonably be considered to be productive.

Q In your opinion, will an unorthodox location as opposed to an orthodox location have any advantage from a standpoint of productivity of this well as to the Morrow "A" sand?

A. As far as the Morrow "A" sand is concerned, a southerly move to an orthodox location, nineteen hundred and eighty feet from the north line and six hundred and sixty feet from the west line of Section 5 would probably not result in any loss in net pay thickness.

Q. Do you have any further comments regarding this exhibit?

A. No, sir, I don't.

Q. I would like for you now to look at Exhibit Number
Three and tell us what that shows, Mr. Hunter?

A. Exhibit Number Three is a map covering the same area as Exhibit Number Two, with the same markings for the unit boundaries and well designations. The difference is that we have mapped the Morrow "B" sand net pay isopach on this map

Q. All right, in your opinion will an unorthodox location as opposed to an orthodox location have any advantage from a standpoint of productivity of the well in the Morrow "B" sand?

A. Yes, sir, it is apparent from looking at this isopach that the farther north we move in our proration unit, the thicker the pay becomes. A location at an orthodox location nineteen hundred and eighty feet from the north line, six hundred and sixty feet from the west line, would very possibly not result in sufficient net pay to make a commercial completion.

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  Three into what the Commission considers one sand, Morrow sand,
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- A. No, sir, not in any way. We are not crowding any offset operators at all.
- Q And also in your opinion will the unorthodox location promote conservation and prevent waste?
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MR. PETERSON: Mr. Examiner, I would like to move that Amoco's Exhibits One through Three be admitted into evidence.

MR. NUTTER: Amoco's Exhibits One through Three will be admitted into evidence.
