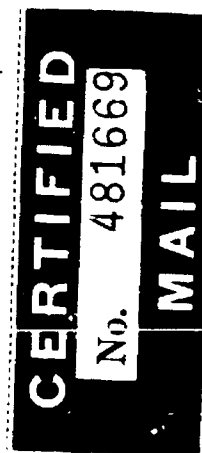

10 MR. STAMETS: Case 5717 will be dismissed.

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



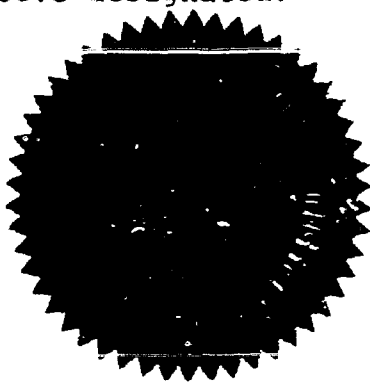
