In Case 5848 Yates Petroleum Corporation requests approval of the unorthodox gas well location of its proposed No. 1 Pipkin HE to be drilled six, sixty from the south and six, sixty from the west lines of Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 25 East, Eddy County. The south half of the section would be dedicated to the well.

Number One and ask is that was prepared by you or under your supervision?

- A. It was prepared under my supervision.
- Q. And would you explain to the Hearing Officer what that exhibit purports to show?
- A. Exhibit Number One is a land plat showing the proposed location and its relationship to the surrounding leasehold situation. It may be noted that the unorthodox movement of the location is mainly toward Yates Petroleum's leasehold.
- Q I refer you to Applicant's Exhibit Number Two and ask if that was prepared by you or under your supervision?
 - A. It was prepared by me.
 - Q What does that exhibit show?
- A. Exhibit Number Two is a map showing the structure, porosity and facies relationship of the quote, Permo-Penn, unquote, carbonates southwest of Artesia. This Permo-Penn interval is stratigraphically equivalent to the overall interval which produces in the Tom Brown Antelope Sink Unit No. 1 located in the southwest of the northeast of Section 18, 19 South, 24 East, Eddy County.

Since it is a stratigraphic equivalent, in order to avoid other nomenclatural problems we suggest that it be referred to as the Antelope Sink zone for these purposes.

The map shows three main facies, that is a tight shelf facies to the northwest which may be correlated into a

narrow band of more porous productive basin margin facies and further southeast, the nonproductive basinal fill shale and tight thin silt sandy carbonates which are very difficult to correlate with the others.

Wells colored in red are completed in the Antelope
Sink zone, contouring the porosity in feet shown in solid
contours indicates that the proposed location should encounter
porosity in the Antelope Sink zone, although the main reason
for the nonstandard location is to encounter a quality section
interval in the gas productive Permo-Penn carbonates. The well
will be drilled through the entire Pennsylvanian and will
adequately test the Morrow formation.

This nonstandard location does improve our chances for encountering two pays.

- Q I refer you to Applicant's Exhibit Number Three,
 Mr. Beck, and ask if that was prepared by you or under your
 supervision?
 - A. It was prepared by me.
- Q. Would you explain to the Hearing Officer what that exhibit purports to show?
- A. Exhibit Number Three is a cross section A to A prime, running from the northwest to the southeast more or less normal to the facies trends shown on the previous map. The Antelope Sink interval is shown on the cross section and this would give some depth dimension to the previous exhibit.
