ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER

BY THE COMMISSIONER:

This cause came on for hearing at 10 o'clock a.m. on May 19, 1954,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico,
hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this ^{25th} day of May, 1954, the Commission, a quorum
being present, having considered the testimony presented and exhibits re-
ceived at said hearing,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law,
the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That a new pool should be created in Eddy County, New Mexico,
as properly advertised, to be designated the Angell-Seven Rivers Pool.

(3) That extensions should be approved as advertised, and as modi-
fied in testimony presented at the subject hearing, for the following pools:
Benton-Wolfcamp, Lollarhide-Jasen, Langlie-Wittin and Livingston-Paddock (all
of which are oil pools); and for the Surrent Gas Pool.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission be, and the
same hereby is approved, as follows:

(a) That a new pool should be created in Eddy County, New Mexico,
classified as an oil pool for Seven Rivers production, designated as the
Angell-Seven Rivers Pool, and described as:

Section 19 South, Range 23 East, T14N
R17E, Section 24

(b) That the Angell-Seven Rivers Pool, as a restricted classification
defined in description, shall be extended to include therein:

Section 14 South, Range 23 East, T14N
R17E, Section 24

(c) That the Lollarhide-Jasen Pool, as a restricted classification
defined in description, shall be extended to include therein:

Section 25 South, Range 23 East, T14N
R17E, Section 24

(d) That the Langlie-Wittin Pool, as a restricted classification,
defined in description, shall be extended to include therein:

Section 25 South, Range 23 East, T14N
R17E, Section 24

(C) that the present Gas Tool boundary as heretofore established, defined and described should be extended to include:

Township 21 South, Range 30 East, NMR
1/4 Section 2

(F) that the present Gas Tool boundary as heretofore established, defined and described should be extended to include:

Township 21 South, Range 30 East, NMR
Lots 1 - 13, incl., and SE/4 Section 1;
Lots 1 - 10, incl., and lots 13 and 16
of Section 2;
Lots 1, 2, 7 and 8 of Section 3;
E/2 of Section 12;
E/2 and SW/4 of Section 13;
SE/4 Section 14

Southeastern New Mexico nomenclature case, for creation of new pools and extension of existing pools, as follows: (a) Creation of the Angell-Seven Rivers Oil Pool (in Eddy County) for production from the Seven River Formation, described as: Township 19 South, Range 28 East NE¹/₄ Section 28 (b) Extension of the Denton-Wolfcamp Pool boundary to include: Township 14 South, Range 37 East, N¹/₂ Section 26; SE¹/₄ Section 23 (c) Extension of the Dollarhide-Queen Pool boundary to include: Township 25 South, Range 38 East, All of Section 4 (lying within the State of New Mexico) (d) Extension of the Langlie-Mattix Pool boundary to include: Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NE¹/₄, NE¹/₄, S¹/₂ NE¹/₄ and SE¹/₄ of Section 24 (e) Extension of the Lovington-Paddock Pool boundary to include: Township 17 South, Range 36 East E¹/₂ of Section 2 (f) Extension of the Eumont Gas Pool boundary to include: Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lots 1-16, incl., and SE¹/₄ Section 1; Lots 1-10, incl., and Lots 15 and 16 of Section 2; Lots 1, 2, 7 and 8 of Section 3; E¹/₂ of Section 12; E¹/₂ and SE¹/₄ of Section 13; SE¹/₄ Section 14. a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By: MR. HETTS:

Q Will you state your name, please?

A Randall Field Montgomery.

Q What is your position with the Oil Conservation Commission?

A Geologist, New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

Q You are familiar with Case Number 713?

A Yes, sir.

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Q Do you have any recommendation to make in that regard?

A I recommend that the Commission adopt the creation and extensions as advertised, with the exception of 713 B, that the north half of Section 26 was taken in in Order R-386. Also that it take in the southwest quarter of Section 23 with the southeast quarter of Section 23, Township 14 South, Range 3 East.

Q You wish to extend this to include the southwest quarter of Section 23?

A Yes, sir.

Q It will be understood for the record, that any objection to this that is made may be heard at a later date.

A Yes, sir. The other exception would be in 713 D, that is the northeast of the southwest be added to the advertisement.

Q Northeast quarter of what?

A Of the southwest quarter of Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 36 East.

Q Again with the understanding that any objection made because of the error in advertising may be presented to the Commission?

A Yes, sir.

Q You have any exhibits there that you wish to submit?

A Yes, sir, Exhibits 1 through 7.

Q Those were not actually prepared by you?

A No, sir.

Q But you have looked them over, and you are satisfied as to their accuracy?

A Yes, sir, I am.

MR. KITTEN: No more the admission of the exhibits, Exhibits 1 through 7.

MR. WATKINS: Without objection, they will be admitted.
