A Yes, sir, I have.

- Q Would you state to the Commission your conclusion as a result of the study and your recommendation?
- A I recommend that the pool be created as advertised. The pool was discovered by the Leonard Oil Company. The discovery well was the Well No. 2, Lois C. Hobbs, in Unit I of 23-15-30, completed on 4-3-1956 in the Queen Formation. Top of the perforation is 2770. I recommend that the pool be created as advertised.
- Q Have you also had an opportunity to study the proposed creation of new oil pool for Devonian production designated as the Spencer-Devonian Pool?

 A Yes, I have.
 - Q What are your recommendations and conclusion?
- A I recommend that the pool be created as advertised, that being the Spencer-Devonian, the northwest quarter of Section 25, Township 17 South, Range 36 East. The discovery well in this field was the J. C. Williamson Spencer Unit No. 1 located in Unit C of Section 25, completed on 5/7/56, the dcs. 11,033 feet to the Devonian.
- Q Have you had an opportunity to study the proposed extension of the Baish Pool?
- A Yes, sir. I recommend that the Baish Pool be extended as advertised.
- Q Have you had an opportunity to study the proposed extension of the Corbin-Yates?
 - A Yes, and I further recommend that it be extended as advertised.

Q Have you made a study of the proposed extension of the E. K.-Queen Pool?

A Yes, I have. I recommend that it be extended as advertised and also there was an unadvertised portion, the south half of Section 14, Township 18 South, Range 33 East. I recommend that it be extended to include that area also and is continuous and contiguous.

- Q It is contiguous acreage?
- A To the present pool, that is correct.
- Q To that which was advertised? A No, to the pool.
- Q Have you had an opportunity to study the proposed extension of the Jalmat Pool?
 - A Yes, sir, I recommend that it be extended as advertised.
- Q Have you made a study of the proposed extension of the Langlie-Mattix?
- A I have. I further recommend that it be extended as advertised.
- Q You made a study of the proposed extension of the North Mason-Delaware Pool?
 - A I have and I recommend it be extended as advertised.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on June 14, 1966, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, bereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

MOW, on this 9^{15} day of July, 1956, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises.

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Queen formation, said pool to bear the designation Cedar Point-Queen Pool. Said Cedar Point-Queen Pool was discovered by Leonard Oil Company Lois C. Hobbs #2, located in the NE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 23, Township 15 South, Range 30 East, NMPM. It was completed April 3, 1956. The top of the perforations is at 2770'.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation Spencer-Devonian Pool. Said Spencer-Devonian Pool was discovered by J. C. Williamson Spencer Unit #1, located in the NE/4 NW/4 Section 25, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM. It was completed May 7, 1956. The depth of the casing shoe is 11,033'.

(4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Baish Pool, the Corbin-Yates Pool, the E-K Queen Pool, the Jalmat Gas Pool, the Langlie-Mattix Pool and the Wantz-Ato Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico, and the North Mason-Delaware Pool in Lea and Eddy Counties, New Mexico.
