ELVIS A. UTZ

called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY: MR. COOLEY:

- Q Will you state your name and position please?
- A Elvis A. Utz, engineer with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.
- Q Mr. Utz, in your official capacity for the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, have you had an opportunity to make a study of Northwestern New Mexico nomenclature?
 - A Yes, I have.
- Q Mr. Utz, what are your recommendations concerning the creation of a new oil pool for Gallup production designated as the

Gallegos-Gallup Oil Pool?

A In view of the fact that there appears to be somewhat of a disagreement as to whether or not this is all one continuous pool, and there are at least two opinions in this matter, I recommend it be dismissed and advertised at a later date, and that studies be made immediately to determine whether this is one pool or not. It appears that we may have a gas cap and it also appears that the gas cap may be a separate pool from the oil production. That, I think, should be determined as soon as possible.

Q Thank you. What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Blanco Mesaverde Pool?

A I recommend that the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well completed and capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well completed in this pool.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning the extension of the Otero-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A Yes, I recommend that the Otero-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of four wells capable of producing from that pool?

G And what are your recommendations concerning the

A I likewise recommend that the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of four wells completed and capable of producing from that pool.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning the extension of the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool?

A Yes, sir, I recommend that the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well completed in that pool.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning the extension of the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool?

A I also recommend that the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of three wells completed and capable of producing from that pool.

Q Do you have any further recommendations in this case, Mr. Utz?

A I do not. I have an exhibit which I have marked Case 1355, Exhibit 1, which shows my recommendations together with the wells on which those recommendations are based.

Q Was this exhibit prepared by you or under your supervision?

A It was prepared under my supervision.

MR. COOLEY: I offer at this time Exhibit No. 1 in Case 1355.

MR. PORTER: Without objection, it will be admitted.

TMR. COOLMY: That is all.

CROSS EXAMINATION

BY: MR. PORTER:

Q Mr. Utz, back on Paragraph B, how many wells did you say this extension is based on?

A That's the Blanco Mesaverde?

Q Yes, sir.

A One well.

MR. PORTER: Thank you. Does anyone have a question of Mr. Utz? If not, the witness may be excused.

(Witness excused.)

MR. PORTER: Does anyone have any statement to make concerning Case 1355?

For the benefit of anyone who may be interested, the Commission will dismiss Paragraph A of Case 1355 and take the balance of the case under advisement, and the hearing is recessed until tomorrow morning.

THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN SAN JUAN AND RIO ARRIBA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on December 18, 1957, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this $30^{\frac{t}{2}}$ day of December, 1957, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the proposed creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Gallup formation, advertised as the proposed Gallegos-Gallup Oil Pool, should be dismissed pending further study.
- (3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Otero-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool and the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool, both in San Juan County, New Mexico, and to the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool, and the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, all in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (a) That the proposed creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Gallup formation, advertised as the Gallegos-Gallup Oil Pool, be and the same is hereby dismissed.


