- Mr. Arnold, in your capacity with the Oil Conservation Commission, have you made a study concerning the necessity or desirability for extending the certain pools in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico?



A Yes, I have.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as shown in paragraph (a), Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well completed in this pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Pine Lake-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the Pine Lake-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as shown in paragraph (b), Exhibit 1, on the basis of three wells completed in this pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as shown in paragraph (c), Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well completed in this pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool?

A I recommend that the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool be extended as shown in paragraph (d), Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well completed in this pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Horseshoe Gallup Oil Pool?

A I recommend that the Horseshoe Gallup Oil Pool be extended as shown in paragraph (e), Exhibit 1, on the basis of five



wells completed in this pool.

What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool?

I recommend that the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool be extended as shown in paragraph (f), Exhibit 1, on the basis of three wells completed in this pool.

Have you prepared an exhibit substantiating your recommendations?

Yes, it's marked Exhibit No. 1, Case 1921.

MR. PAYNE: I move for the introduction of Exhibit No. l in Case No. 1921.

MR. PORTER: Without objection it will be admitted. Anyone have any questions? If not, the witness will be excused. (Witness excused.)

MR. PORTER: If nothing further, the case will be taken under advisement, and the hearing adjourned.
