- What do you recommend relative to creating the Gallup production?
- I recommend that a new oil pool for Gallup production be A created and designated as the La Plata-Gallup Oil Pool. I recommend that the limits should be defined as S/2 of Section 5, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, the discoveror of the well was Standard of Texas 5-1 Federal 12 and unit N of Section 5, completed 3-22-59. Top perforations 5347'.
- Do you recommend Aztec be extended as shown in paragraph B?
  - Α Yes, on the basis of one well completed.
- Q Do you recommend the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as shown on paragraph C?
- On the basis of five wells which have been completed in this pool.
