ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 17, 1963, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 22nd day of July, 1963, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Gallup formation, said pool to bear the designation of Many Rocks-Gallup Oil Pool. Said Many Rocks-Gallup Oil Pool was discovered by Curtis J. Little, Navajo 27 No. 2, located in Unit N of Section 27, Township 32 North, Range 17 West, NMPN. It was completed in Gallup on November 15, 1962. The top of perforations is 1240 feet.
- (3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Devils Fork-Gallup Pool, the Puerte Chiquito-Gallup Oil Pool, and the Boulder-Mancos Oil Pool, all in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

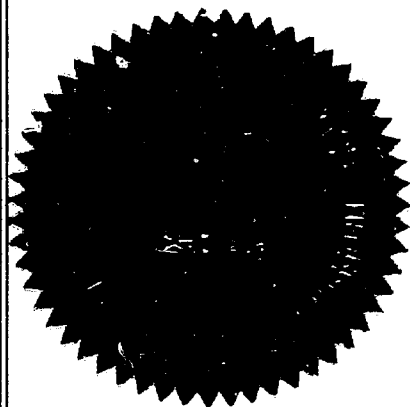
