

#### CRIMEN OF THE COMMISSION

#### BY THE COMOR SSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on October 16, 1963, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinefter referred to as the "Commission."

Mbi, on this 30th day of Outober, 1963, the Commission, a quoyan being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits receive at each bearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the redesignation of the Rattlesnake-Fennsylvanian Oil Fool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as the Rattlesnake-Fennsylvanian "CB" Oil Fool and to define the vertical limits of said pool as; top of pool being that point correlative to the point depicted at 6554 feet and bottom of pool correlative to the point depicted at 6827 feet on the log of the Continental Rattlesnake Well No. 136 located in Unit J of Section 2, Township 29 North Range 19 West, NACH.
- (3) That there is need for the redesignation of the Fuerto Chiquito-Gallup Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as the Puerto Chiquito-Mances Oil Fool and to define the vertical limits of said pool as; top of pool being that point correlative to the point depicted at 1997 feet and bettem of pool correlative to the point depicted at 3143 feet on the log of the Intex Hijo Well No. 1 located in Unit F of Section 5, Township 26 North, Range 1 Hast NECH. (From the top of the Niobrara formation to the bettom of the Greenhorn formation).
- (4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation of Rattlesnake-Pennsylvanian "B" Pool.

-2-Order No. R-2580 Case No. 2920

Said Rattlesnake-Pennsylvanian "B" Fool was discovered by Continental Oil Company's, Rattlesnake Well No. 144 located in Unit N of Section 2, Township 29 North, Range 19 West, NAPH. It was completed in Pennsylvanian "B" on June 8, 1962. The top of the perforations is 6402 feet. Commission today that it issue an order creating and extending certain pools in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties and concerning the designation and redesignation of certain vertical limits and have you prepared your recommendations in the form of an exhibit?

- Yes, I have.
- How is that marked, Mr. Arnold?
- Exhibit No. 1, Case 2920. Α
- And is this exhibit basically similar to the docket that has been prepared and distributed here today?
  - Yes, I believe it is exactly the same as the docket.
- Would you, please, refer to the exhibit and to the docket and briefly summarize your recommendations to the Commission?
- Paragraph "A" the recommendation is to redesignate the Rattlesnake-Pennsylvanian Oil Pool in San Juan County as the Rattlesnake-Pennsylvanian "CD" Oil Pool, and to define the vertical limits to be from the depth correlative to the point depicted at 6554 feet on the log of Continental Rattlesnake Well No. 136, located in Unit "J" of Section 2, Township 29 North, Range 19 West, to a depth correlative to the point depicted at 6827 feet on said log.

That's right. And, so, its necessary to create a gas pool?

Yes, we have, based upon Continental's recommendations, Q designated four producing zones in that area, Zones A, B, C, and D, and the Rattlesnake-Pennsylvanian Oil Pool is completed in two of these zones, the C and D Zones, and the Rattlesnake-Pennsyl vanian Gas Pool is completed in the "B" Zone. The 136 Well was, I believe, originally completed as a gas well in the B Zone, in fact, it was the discovery well for the B Zone, and it has since been recompleted as an oil well in the CD Zone, that's the reason the discovery well in the B Zone even though its not

completed in that zone at the present time.

MR. PORTER: Thank you, does anyone else have a question of this witness? You may be excused.
