# ALLOWABLE: (1) Consideration of the oil allowable for December, 1963.

(2) Consideration of the allowable production of gas for December, 1963, for ten prorated pools in Lea and Eddy Counties, New Mexico, and also presentation of purchaser's nominations for the six-month period beginning January 1, 1964 for that area. Consideration of the allowable production of gas for nine prorated pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico for December, 1963.

# CASE 2935:

## ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

## BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on November 13, 1963, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this day of November, 1963, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

## FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.
- / (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Bone Springs formation, said pool to bear the designation of North Bell Lake-Bone Springs Pool. Said North Bell Lake-Bone Springs Pool was discovered by Continental Oil Company, Bell Lake Unit No. 9, located in the SW/t. Unit K of Section 18, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. It was completed in Bone Springs on June 16, 1962. The top of perforations is 8542 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the abolishment of the West Grossroads-San Andres Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, in order to consolidate two pools producing from the same/reservoir and whose pool boundaries are contiguous.

  Abolished acreage to be extended to the Jenkins-San Andres Pool.
- (4) That there is need for the extension of the vertical limits of the Red Lake Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, to thereby include the Queen formation underlying Unit G of Section 9 only in Township 17 South, Range 28
- (5) That there is need for certain extensions to the Red Lake Pool, the Lusk-Strawn Pool, both in Eddy County, New Mexico, the Jenkins-San Andree Pool, the Blinebry Pool, the Double AZAbo Pool, the Flying "M"-Abo Pool, the North Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool, the Nonument-Tubb Pool, and the Wilson-Yates Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

# IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Bone Springs production, is hereby created and designated as the North Bell Lake-Bone Springs Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(b) That the West Crossroads-San Andres Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, consisting of the following described area:
