In my opinion, this would not be permitted on Lease E-8249 for these reasons: Paragraph 16 in the statutory lease contract authorizes the completion of a well in the extended term of a lease where a lessee is engaging in bona fide of drilling or re-working at the time of the expiration date. This was not intended to be an extension of the lease contract, but an extension in order to provide time to complete the well being drilled. Further, from your report, you have drilled and completed a dry hole, and this would mean that the lease has automatically terminated. The lease has been stipulated to the 1957 form; however, this gives you no additional rights since production has not been established upon this lease.
