## Gentlemen:

Shar-Alan Oil Company hereby requests that a hearing be set to create a new pool to be known as the Rosa Gallup-Mesaverde Field. This request is made based upon the completion of the Rosa Unit No. 49 well.

The Rosa Unit No. 49 was perforated in the Gallup formation from 6895' to 7025' and in the Mecaverde from 6115' to 6275'. The area perforated in both zones are of extremely low permeability resulting in a well of very marginal value as a gas producer. Due to this low permeability in these zones we can show that there is no communication between this well and the Blanco Pool. Also there is no Gallup production within thirty miles of this well.

In the event the Commission should reject this request, it would be necessary to plug this well because of the economics involved thereby leaving gas in the ground which could not be produced.

Please advise when this hearing can be set up.
