ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 16, 1966, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this day of February, 1966, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Lea Gounty, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation of South Kemnitz-Upper Wolfcamp Pool. Said South Kemnitz-Upper Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by Pennzoil Company, Gulf-State No. 1, located in the SE/J. Unit P of Section 32, Township 16 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. It was completed in Wolfcamp on January 1, 1966. The top of perforations is 10,189 feet. Special vertical limits are defined as being from the top of the Wolfcamp at 9857 feet to the shale break at 10,816 feet.
