APPLICATION

Comes now Skelly Oil Company and alleges and states:

- l. That it is an operator in the Lazy "J" (Penn.) Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2. That it has completed its Childress "A" Well No. 1 at a location 1,980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 1, Township 14 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Lazy "J" (Penn.) Pool, with a total depth of 10,030 feet and a plugged back total depth of 9,934 feet.
- 3. That it perforated the Abo formation between the interval of 8,836 feet to 8,914 feet, and perforated the Wolfcamp formation between the interval of 9,852 feet and 9,885 feet. A packer was set at 9,810 feet, and the Abo formation is presently isolated behind the packer. The well was completed in the Wolfcamp formation and the production from said formation has declined to the point where it will no longer flow its allowable and it is necessary and desirable that pumping equipment be installed in this well.
- 4. Applicant proposes to remove the packer and produce both the Abo and Wolfcamp formations by commingling same in the well bore without a packer so as to more efficiently produce the well and to produce the hydrocarbons from both formations to achieve the greatest amount of ultimate recovery and allow the recovery of oil which would otherwise not be recovered.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, applicant prays that this Commission set this matter down for hearing, that notice hereof be given as required by law, and that at the conclusion of said hearing based on the evidence adduced enter its order allowing Skelly 0il Company to commingle the production from the Abo and Wolfcamp formations in the well bore of its Childress "A" Well No. 1, located 1,980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 1, Township 14 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and for such other orders, rules and regulations as may be necessary in the premises.
