Comes Roger C. Hanks, Ltd, a partnership, with offices in the Oil & Gas Building, Wichita Falls, Texas, acting by and through the undersigned attorneys, and hereby makes application for the promulgation of special field rules for the Bar-U Pennsylvanian Pool situated in Township 9 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M. Lea County, New Mexico, and with respect thereto respectfully shows:

1. That applicant is the owner of 3 producing wells, being the only wells located in the Bar-U Pennsylvanian Pool; Lea County, New Mexico producing from the Bough-C Pennsylvanian formation, said wells being located as follows: Roger Hanks-Bridwell State No. 1 located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 32 East; Roger Hanks-Bridwell No. 2 located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 32 East; and Roger Hanks-Ralph Lowe No. 1 located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, Township 9 South, Range 32 East. That applicant owns or controls the 160 acre governmental quarter sections upon which each of the above wells are located and in addition, other leasehold interests which have not been developed in the immediate area.

2. That to the best of applicant's knowledge and belief each of the above mentioned wells will effectively and efficiently drain more than 160 acres and that any other wells drilled within the Bar-U Pennsylvanian Pool likewise will effectively and efficiently drain more than 160 acres. Applicant seeks an order providing for special


field rules, including 160 acre spacing consisting of the governmental quarter section upon which each well is located; however, because of the large water production from said wells, applicant only seeks the establishment of 80 acre allowables for each 160 acre spacing unit.

3. That to the best of applicant's knowledge and belief the establishment of special field rules for the Bar-U Pennsylvanian Pool, including 160 acre spacing, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights and will be in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

4. That applicant requests that this matter be heard at the last examiner's hearing in November, 1967.

Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks the promulgation of special pool rules for the Bar-ll Pennsylvanian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, including a provision for 160-acre spacing units and the establishment of 80-acre allowables for said 160-acre units.

CASE 3707: Application of William B. Barnhill for a dual completion, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks approval for the dual completion (conventional) of his Keohane Well No. 1 located in Unit N of Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico, to produce oil from the Skaggs-Grayburg and undesignated Blinbry pool through parallel strings of tubing.

CASE 3708: Application of BTA Oil Producers for special area rules, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant proposes the adoption of 160-acre proration units for the above-described area, or within one mile thereof, for the Bough "C" zone of the Pennsylvanian formation with each proration unit to be assigned an 80-acre proportional factor of 4.77 for allowable purposes.

Applicant proposes that the rules presently contained in Commission

Order No. R-3179-A, Temporary Rules, Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool, be adopted and made permanent for the above-described area or, in the alternative, that the above-described land be deleted from the Lane-Pennsylvanian and Middle-Lane Pennsylvanian Pools and the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool be extended to include said lands therein.

Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks authority to dually complete its Navajo Table Mesa Well No. 2, located in Unit O of Section 27, Township 28 North, Range 17 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Table Mesa-Pennsylvanian "C" Oil Pool and the disposal of produced salt water through the intermediate casing-production casing annulus into the Organ Rock formation through perforations in said intermediate casing from approximately 5505 feet to 5525 feet.
- CASE 3690: Application of Roger C. Hanks, Ltd., for special pool rules, Lea County, New Mexico.
