That since the order defining the limits of the Baum-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool was entered on July 1, 1968, additional wells have been drilled in the pool outside of the above limits and wells are in the process of being drilled which will further extend the limits of said pool toward the north and will be within one mile of the limits of the Lazy J Pennsylvanian pool as defined by order R-3280 entered by the Commission on August 1, 1967.
