MR. PORTER: We will take up Case 3999.

MR. HATCH: Southeastern nomenclature case calling for an order for the creation, extension, and contraction of certain pools in Lea and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico.

(Whereupon, Commission's Exhibit Number 1, was marked for identification.)

JOE RAMEY

called as a witness by the Commission, having been first duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. HATCH:

- Q Will you state your name and position for the record?
- A Joe Ramey, Supervisor of Commission's District 1.
- Q Are you prepared to make recommendations to the Commission concerning the creation, extension, and contraction of certain pools in Lea and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico?
 - A Yes, sir.
- Q Were your recommendations prepared in the form of exhibits?
- A Yes. That is labeled Southern Nomenclature, Exhibit paragraph A through G.
- Q Would you refer to paragraph A of that exhibit, and make your recommendations to the Commission concerning the

creation of a new pool described in paragraph A?

A It is recommended that a new oil pool be created and designated as the Cindy-Wolfcamp Pool, the vertical limits to be the Wolfcamp Formation and the horizontal limits as shown in paragraph A.

Discovery well was the Meadco Properties, Ltd.Phillips State No. 1, located in Unit N of Section 22,
Township 11 South, Range 36 East, and was completed on October
30, 1968.

Top of the perforations is at 9,918 feet. It is further recommended that this well be assigned a discovery allowable of 49,590 barrels.

- Q Will you go ahead then with the rest of the exhibit, paragraph B through G, and point out to the Commission any correction or additions needed to be made.
 - A The remainder is as advertised on the docket.
- Ω Do you recommend to the Commission that the pools be extended and contracted as advertised?
 - A Yes, sir, I do.
- Q Was Exhibit 1 prepared by you or someone under your supervision?
 - A Yes, it was.

MR. HATCH: I move the introduction of Exhibit 1 into

evidence.

MR. PORTER: If there is no objection to the exhibit, it will be admitted.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on December 18, 1968, at Santa Pe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 23rd day of December, 1968, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation of Cindy-Wolfcamp Pool. Further, that the discovery well for said pool, the Meadco Properties, Ltd. Phillips State Well No. 1, located in Unit N of Section 22, Township 11 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, is entitled to and should receive a bonus discovery allowable in the amount of 49,590 barrels to be assigned over a two-year period. The top of the perforations in said well is at 9918 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the contraction of the Eumont Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, by the deletion of certain

acreage in order that the deleted acreage may be placed in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

(4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Bar-U Pennsylvanian Pool, the South Corbin-Morrow Gas Pool, the East EK-Queen Pool, the Jalmat Gas Pool, and the North Vacuum-Lower Wolfcamp Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Wolfcamp production, is hereby created and designated as the Cindy-Wolfcamp Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM Section 22: SW/4

That the discovery well for said pool, the Meadco Properties, Ltd. Phillips State Well No. 1, located in Unit M of Section 22, Township 11 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, is hereby authorized an oil discovery allowable of 49,590 barrels to be assigned to said well at the rate of 68 barrels per day in accordance with Rule 509 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
