This report shall be filed in duplicate on or before the 15th day of each calendar month with the District Office of The Railroad Commission of Texas to which the field covered by said report is assigned. The report shall be complete as to data covering the month next preceding the date of filing. The producer shall furnish a copy of this report to each transporter moving oil from each lease covered by this report.

Do not include fluid in gun-barrels or similar treating system. Explain fully under Remarks any stock reported that is not contained in lease stock tanks.

All amounts of oil shall be reported in barrels computed from 100% tank tables and based upon actual physical gauges.

Do not use fractions of barrels in this report.

Make a separate report for each field or pool.

Please use typewriter if possible.

Do not send this report to Austin.

GENTLEMEN:

The Production Office and State Geologist's office have received a number of letters from producing operators in the State of New Mexico expressing dissatisfaction with the Commission's recently adopted FORMER'S MONTHLY CRUDE PRODUCTION OIL REPORT Form C-108. It was thought at the time this form was made up that it could be filled out at the same time the Federal Federal Form was made out but it now appears that this is impossible.

At the request of Mr. H. J. Kemler, Chairman of the Sub-Advisory Committee the engineers have prepared a sample form combining C-108 and C-109, copy of which is enclosed herewith. It is believed that this new form includes the necessary information previously contained in the other two reports.

It will be greatly appreciated if you will give this sample form your consideration and notify the writer of your criticisms, comments, suggestions, etc.; and if, in your opinion, the Conservation Commission should be petitioned by the Les County Operators Committee to adopt same.
